World Bank allocates \$8 billion to China

- The World Bank has allocated about \$8 billion for the infrastructure projects of the Chinese initiative - Silk Road Economic Belt.
- The round table meeting at Beijing, held on September 12 was in the "6+ 1" format with the heads of international financial and economic oraanizations. The heads were Chinese Premier of the State Council Li Kegiang, World Bank President Jim Yong Kim, Managing Director of the International Monetary Fund Christine Lagarde, Director General of the World Trade Organization Roberto Azevedo, Director General of the International Labor Organization Guy Ryder Secretary General of the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development Angel Gurria
- The initiative to create the Silk Road Economic Belt ("One belt - One road") was proposed by the Chinese President Xi Jinping in 2013.
- This project is aimed at creating a transport, energy and trade corridor between the countries of Central, Eastern, South Asia and Europe.
- The Silk Road Economic Belt comprises 6 corridors which connect five central Asian countries, Iran and the Persian Gulf region, Transcaucasia, Turkey and the Saudi Arabian peninsula.

Sachin Tendulkar launched Mission-24 programme in Mumbai

- Former Indian cricketer Sachin Tendulkar launched Mission-24 programme in Mumbai
- The project was launched by NGOs
 Apnalaya and Mumbai First in
 partnership with the BMC

 Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation.
- Aims to improve the quality of life in a poor ward of Mumbai through collaborative efforts in the next 24 months.
- To provide basic amenities to residents of M-East ward that includes slums of Shivaji Nagar, Deonar and Mankhurd.
- The selected area ranks the lowest in human development index (HDI) among all the 24 administrative wards of the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC).
- The M-East ward has no hospitals, no maternity homes and it survives on one dispensary and 4 health posts at present.
- This programme aims to provide amenities like secondary schools and colleges, aanganwadis, maternity homes, health posts and dispensaries in the ward.

Kerala to open Clinics for Transgender Community

- For the first time in the country, exclusive clinics for the transgender community will start functioning in government medical colleges across the state and will offer sex-change surgeries.
 - The move has been undertaken by the state's Health and Social Justice departments as a part of the state's Transgender Policy unveiled in 2015.
- This will be executed in collaboration with Legal Services Society with an aim to make the state's health sector transgender-friendly.
- The clinics will also help with various health issues unique to transgenders and offer counselling.

The first clinic will be set up at the

- government medical college of
 Kottayam within the next two months
 and will be one of the first clinics to
 provide the sex-change surgery.
- The present government has issued identity cards for the members of the community and has set aside a budget of Rs. 10 crore for their welfare.
- The government has also planned on opening post-surgery shelter homes in Thiruvananthapuram and Ernakulam where the community members can stay for a short while following the surgery.

Google Tez UPI-Based Digital Payments App Launched in India

- Google has launched its mobile payment service, called Tez, in India.
- Tez is a stand-alone application which is available for both Android and iOS.
 About Tez

- The app allows users to transfer money via their bank accounts as well as Unified Payments Interface (UPI) ID, QR code and phone number.
- Google has introduced a reward program under which users can make Rs 51 when referral makes their first payment.
- A user can earn a maximum of Rs
 9,000 per financial year, and user can only be paid once for inviting the same person once. The offer expires on April 1, 2018.
- Along with all major Indian banks,
 Google has also teamed up with
 Dominos, RedBus and PVR as payment partners
- There's also a 'Cash mode transactions' option in the app that allows users to send money instantly to another Tez user nearby without needing to share private details like your bank account or phone number.
- UPI is a payment system launched by the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) and regulated by the Reserve Bank of India which facilitates the instant fund transfer between two bank accounts on the mobile platform.

- These three states will be awarded for showing good progress in the area of reduction in stunting as measured
