- The first recipients of the Bharat Ratna were politician C. Rajagopalachari, philosopher Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, and scientist C. V. Raman, who were honoured in 1954
- Lal Bahadur Shastri became the first individual to be honoured posthumously.
- Sachin Tendulkar is the youngest recipient of Bharata Ratna. He was awarded in 2014
- Recent recipients- Madhan Mohan Malavay and Atal Bihari Vajpayee

- Two non-Indians got Bharata Ratna till now. They are Pakistan national Khan Abdul Ghaffar Khan and former South African President Nelson Mandela

1. SARASWATISAMMAN AWARD- MAHABALESHAWAR SAIL FOR THE YEAR 2017

2. JNANPITH AWARD- SHANKHA GHOSH (RECENT RECIPIENT)

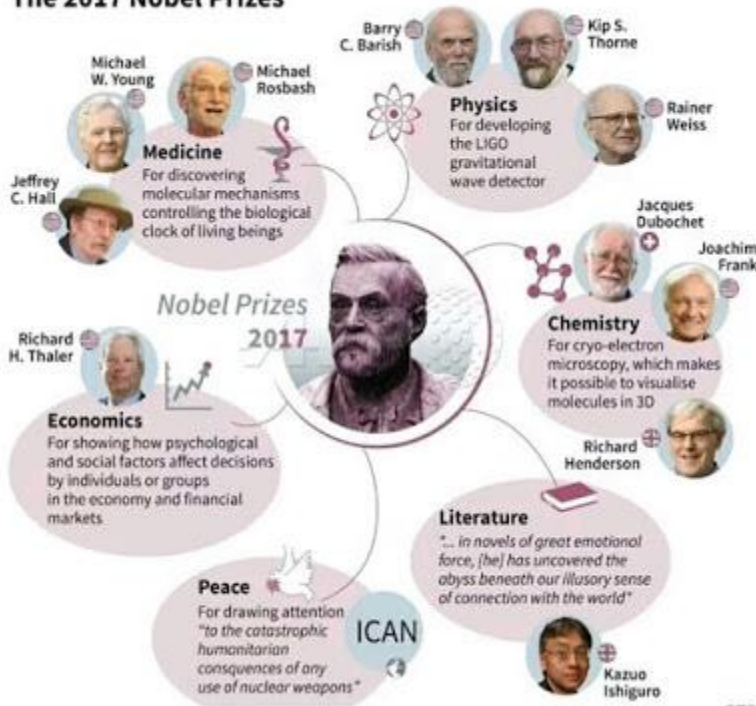

- It is awarded for outstanding contributions for humanity in Physics, Chemistry, economics, literature, peace and medicine
- All Noble prizes Presented by Sweden except Noble prize in the field of peace which is presented by Norway

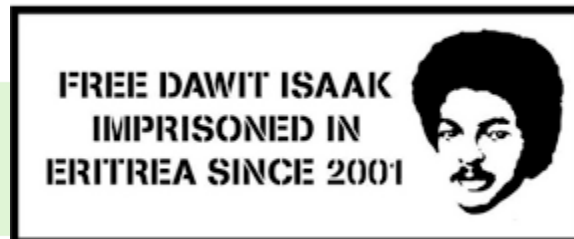

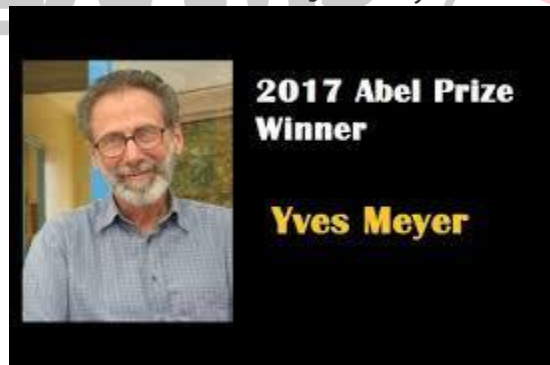
