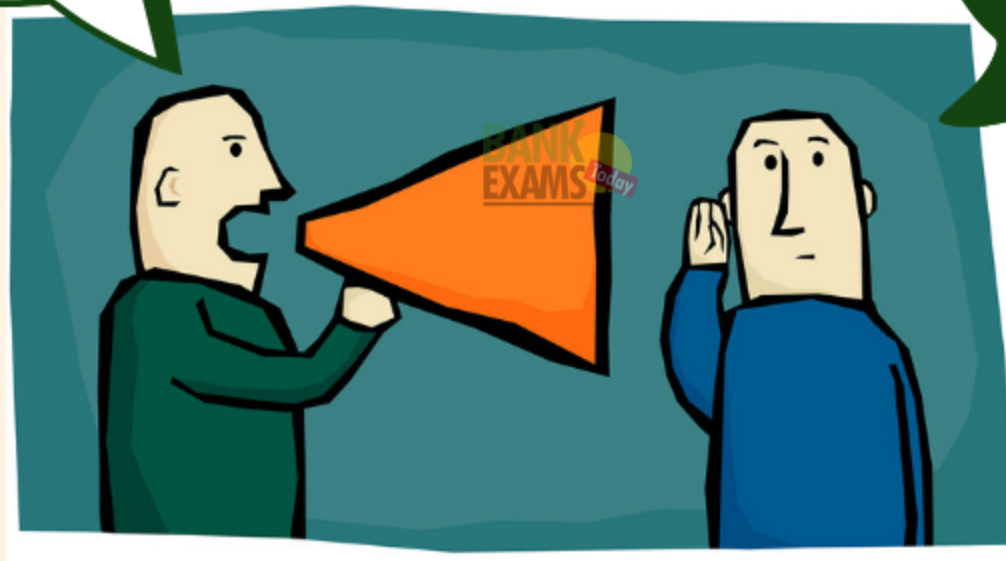

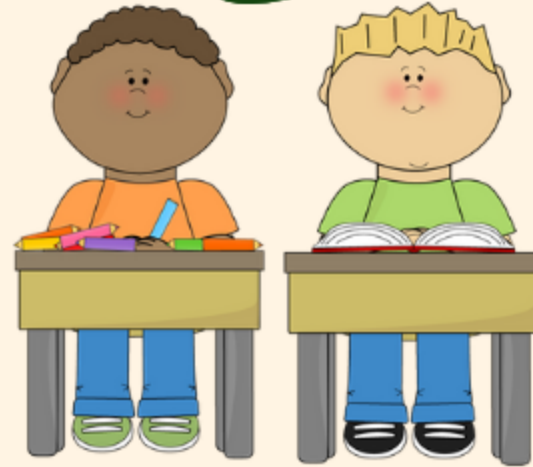
# ACT OUT
