## Banking and Financial Awareness

- Market regulator SEBI has announced to impose penalty if a company violates the minimum public shareholding (MPS) norms.
- PNB MetLife India Insurance has appointed Ashish Srivastava as its new MD and CEO.
- The Reserve Bank of India is to launch a Financial Literacy Drive to educate people on financial awareness like e-transactions, in 9 states.
- The Central Board of Direct Taxes has signed two more advance pricing agreements (APAs) with taxpayers, related to automobile and healthcare consulting sectors.
- Tata AIA Life launched Eazy Connect chatbot, a servicing tool for social media.
- The Government of Odisha and the State Bank of India have signed an MOU for integration of SBI e-Pay with the cyber treasury of the state.
- SBI has launched a new product called SME Assist, to provide a short-term working capital loan to its MSME clients.
- Mastercard has announced the launch of its global research and development arm Mastercard Labs in Pune, India.
- State Bank of India is prepared to set Up Country's Largest Innovation Centre at Mumbai.
- In its latest World Economic Outlook, the IMF lowered India's growth forecast for 2017 to 6.7% from its earlier estimate of 7.2 percent.

- The 5th edition of India Water Week-2017 was inaugurated in New Delhi by President Ram Nath Kovind on October 10, 2017
- The government of India has launched the next series of sovereign gold bond (SGB) scheme, the second in 2017-18.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched an Immunisation Drive from Gujarat's Vadnagar called Intensified Mission Indradhanush.
- Archaeological Survey of India, Ministry of Culture and National Geographic jointly organise the 4th Dialogue of Civilizations from 8th to 15th October 2017.

- Japan has launched fourth Michibiki satellite for a new high-precision global positioning system (GPS).
- SpaceX launched Falcon 9 rocket which carried 10 satellites to bolster the global data communications network for Virginia-based company Iridium.

- World's Largest Combustion Research Centre was inaugurated at IIT Madras, to research in 'Alternative Energy and Environmental Protection'.
- The Indian Air Force (IAF) launched an innovative health mobile App named 'MedWatch' on the occasion of its 85th anniversary
- Amazon Web Services (AWS) and Microsoft have partnered to launch an open-source and deep learning interface 'Gluon' .

- Kolkata is to host the six day International Puppet Festival from 26 October 2017.
- Haryana's Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar announced ration cards for nomadic tribes.
- The Chhattisgarh government has banned the use of chlorinated plastic and short-life Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) used in carry bags.
- Jivamritam filtration system project of Mata Amritanandamayi Math, Kerala which aims to provide clean water to rural India was launched by the President of India.
- Gujarat Government has announced the Garments and Apparel Policy-2017, with the aim of creating more opportunities in the garment sector of Gujarat.
- Himachal Pradesh government implemented the Senior Citizen Health Insurance Scheme (SCHIS) to provide easy access to curative health care services by way of additional cover.
