BANKING AND FINANCIAL AWARENESS

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has added **HDFC Bank** in the list of Domestic Systemically Important Banks (D-SIBs). HDFC Bank is third bank in country to be added in list of D-SIBs after State Bank of India (SBI) and ICICI Bank which were added in 2016.
- Artificial Intelligence (AI)-based chatbot 'Eva' of HDFC bank has successfully addressed over 2.7 million customer queries in six months and became the country's largest banking chatbot.
- It was built for HDFC Bank by Bengaluru-based Senseforth AI Research.
- India's largest public sector bank **State Bank of India (SBI)** has launched its own Artificial Intelligence-powered chatbot **Sia**.
- It will take care of customer queries by giving out information on SBI's range of products and services.
- **Fincare Small Finance Bank** started its banking operations with about 25 operational branches across Gujarat,

Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh.

- The bank (previously known as Disha Microfin Limited) was given final small finance bank (SFB) licence from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) in May this year.
- **Singapore based bank DBS** has got final approval to operate as a wholly-owned subsidiary (WOS) in India. DBS is the second bank after State Bank of Mauritius to receive the nod for its operation in India
- **R A Sankara Narayanan** has taken charge as Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer of Vijaya Bank.
- **K V Rama Moorthy** has appointed as Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer of Tamilnad Mercantile Bank Ltd.
- Punjab National Bank and BSNL has teamed up to roll out open mobile wallet **Speedpay**.
- Income tax department is set to launch **Project Insight** from next month ,which will gather virtual information to trace black money.
- The Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA) has raised upper age limit for joining the

National Pension Scheme (NPS) to **65 years**, from the current 60.

- Paytm Payments Bank has partnered with National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) to launch **RuPay-powered digital debit card**.
- Payment gateway provider **PayU** has collaborated with the Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) to provide online payment services.
- The Ministry of Corporate Affairs and the Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) for automatic sharing of data and information on a regular basis.
- India's foreign exchange (Forex) reserves have crossed **\$400 billion mark** for the first time, according to Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
- The Union Cabinet chaired has given its approval to introduce of the Payment of Gratuity (Amendment) Bill, 2017 in the Parliament.
- All peer-to-peer lending (**P2P**) firms will be treated as non-banking financial companies (NBFCs) and will be regulated by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).

- **Fino Payments Bank** has launched its mobile banking app called **BPay**.
- **SEBI** permitted Real estate investments trusts (REITs) and infrastructure investment trusts (InvITs) to raise funds through debt securities.
- SEBI allowed single-asset REITs similar to InvITs.
- **Vijaya Bank** has bagged the first prize under the Rajbhasha Kirti Puraskar (Region C) for the year 2016-17 for active implementation of Hindi in its day-to-day activities.
- **SBI** bagged first prize under Government of India Rajbhasha Kirti Awards 2016-17 for its Quarterly Hindi house magazine **PRAYAS**.
- Amazon India has tied up with the **Bank of Baroda** to offer micro loans to its sellers.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) has signed a loan of up to USD 200 million with **IndusInd Bank** to provide finance to low-income women borrowers in rural India.
- RBI announced that from October 3, rupee-denominated overseas bonds (masala bonds) will no longer form part

of the limit for FPI (Foreign portfolio investors) investments in corporate bonds.

- ADB, Asian Development Bank has lowered India's growth forecast for this fiscal to 7 %.
- IDBI Bank has launched '**Project Nishchay**' along with The Boston Consulting Group (BCG) to accelerate its turnaround programme and improve financial performance.
- State Bank of India (SBI) has launched **The FTSE SBI Bond Index Series** at London Stock Exchange. It is India's first bond index series for overseas investors.
- SBI has lowered the minimum Average Monthly Balance required in a Savings Bank account to Rs.3000.
- ICICI launched a Cashback Home Loan Scheme, where 1 % cashback is offered on every EMI.

- As per recent "World Nuclear Industry status report" India is third in the world in the number of nuclear reactors being installed.


- London has retained its position as the world's top financial center in the **Global Financial Service Index 2017**.
