# Plausible

seeming reasonable or probable

**Syn:** credible, reasonable, believable, likely, feasible, probable, tenable, possible,

**Atn:** impossible, improbable, inconceivable, irrational, unbelievable

**Exp:** Your business proposal would be **plausible** if you actually had five million dollars in the bank.



# Disdain

**the feeling that someone or something is unworthy of one's respect**

**Syn:** contempt, scorn, derision, disrespect; belittle, undervalue,

**Atn:** admiration, respect, regard, respect, praise, approve

**Exp:** When the politician attacked the separation of church and state, he showed a clear **disdain** for the constitution.



# Unpalatable

**difficult to put up with or accept/not pleasant to taste**

**Syn:** uninviting, unappealing, distressing, lamentable, repugnant, offensive

**Atn:** palatable, tasty, pleasant, acceptable, appetizing

**Exp:** His reasons were good; but his offensive style of argument rendered them **unpalatable**



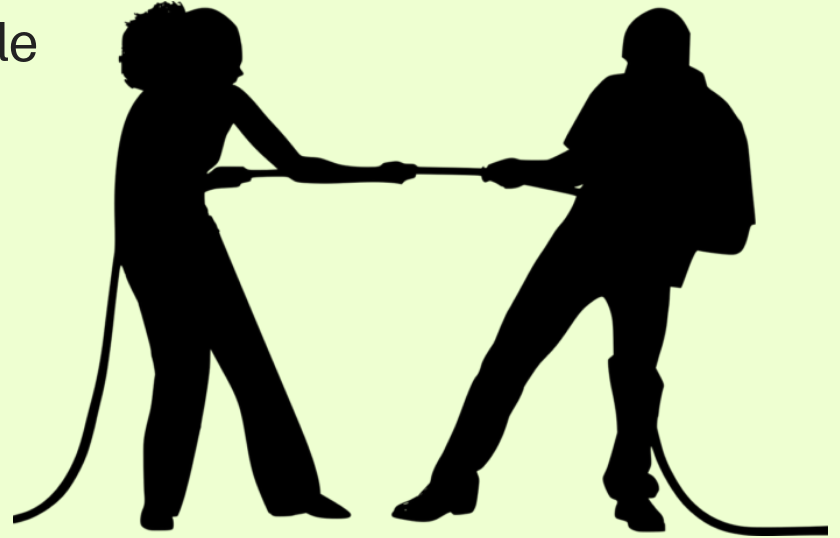
# Tussle

**vigorous struggle or scuffle to obtain or achieve something**

**Syn:** fight, struggle, scrimmage, scramble  
grapple, wrestle, clash,

**Atn:** agreement, harmony, peace,  
accord, calm, retreat, surrender, truce

**Exp:** There was a legal **tussle** over the  
closure of the hospital.



# Reclusive

**avoiding the company of other people; solitary**

**Syn:** solitary, secluded, isolated, hermit-like, cloistered

**Atn:** companionable, convivial, amiable, genial, congenial, cordial, hospitable,

**Exp:** She had been living a reclusive life in Los Angeles since her marriage broke up.
