# DILUTION



**Antonyms:** concentrate, strengthen, thicken



**Meaning:** making a liquid more dilute

People accused that the new act is a **dilution** of their rights in the constitution.

**Synonyms:** Cutting, Thinning

# SANCTIFY



**Antonyms:** dishonour, degrade, adulterate,



**Meaning:** binding by a religious ceremony

Since we are religious, we prayed that God would sanctify our new home

**Synonyms:** Bless, Legitimize, Allow, Purify

# MENACE



Meaning: Threat, Danger

The new initiative aims at beating the menace of drugs

**Synonyms:** Danger, Peril, Risk, Jeopardy

**Antonyms:** friendly, secure, safe, asuspicious



# STEADFAST



**Meaning: Loyal, Faithful**

The civil rights activist remained **steadfast** in his commitment to march to city hall.

**Synonyms:** Devoted, Dedicated, Firm, Inflexible

**Antonyms:** dishonest, unreliable, disloyal,
