FRAUGHT



Antonyms: still, tranquil, quiet, serene, peaceful, pacific, undisturbed



Meaning: causing stress

After CM's death, the state is in a politically fraught situation.

Synonyms: Anxious, Worried, Upset, Frantic

PALPABLE



Meaning: Able to be touched or felt

Because the bank was being robbed, the sense of fear among the patrons was **palpable**.

Synonyms: Noticeable, Notable, Apprant

Antonyms: intangible, imperceptible, ambiguous, improbable, unknown



LACKLUSTRE



Meaning: uninspiring, dull

No excuses were made for the team's **lacklustre** performance

Synonyms: Lifeless, Dull, Insipid, Dreary

Antonyms: bright, enthusiastic, lively
Shining, shiny, spirited



PROFESSED

DHONGI



Antonyms: understate, disregard, ignore, neglect, disown,

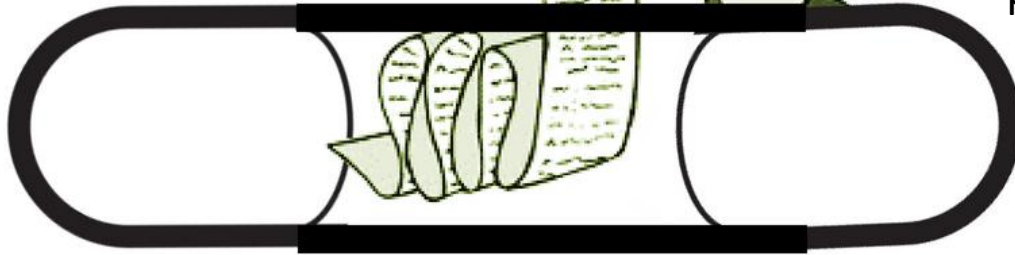


Meaning: claimed openly but often falsely

Adam may profess he is a man of God, but his extramarital affair proves otherwise.

Synonyms: So-called, Pretended, Ostensible

ENCAPSULATE



Antonyms: elongate, extend, lengthen, prolong, amplify, elaborate



Meaning: explain, enclose precisely

The conclusion is encapsulated in one sentence

Synonyms: Confine, Contain, Condense, Abbreviate
