Extradition

handing-over of someone from one jurisdiction to another

Syn: deportation, handover, expulsion, banishment, expulsion ok

Atn: welcoming, approval, permission

Exp: They have applied for his **extradition** to Ireland.



Intractable

hard to control or deal with

Syn: unmanageable, out of control, stubborn, obstinate, obdurate, inflexible,

Atn: willing, manageable, tractable, manipulable, docile

Exp: As the project grew larger, it became **intractable** and required a larger management team



Deploy

bring into effective action

Syn: position, station, arrange, place, install, locate, situate, site

Atn: displace, conclude, end, finish, conceal, disarrange

Exp: A week after his wedding Ryan had to **deploy** overseas with his unit.



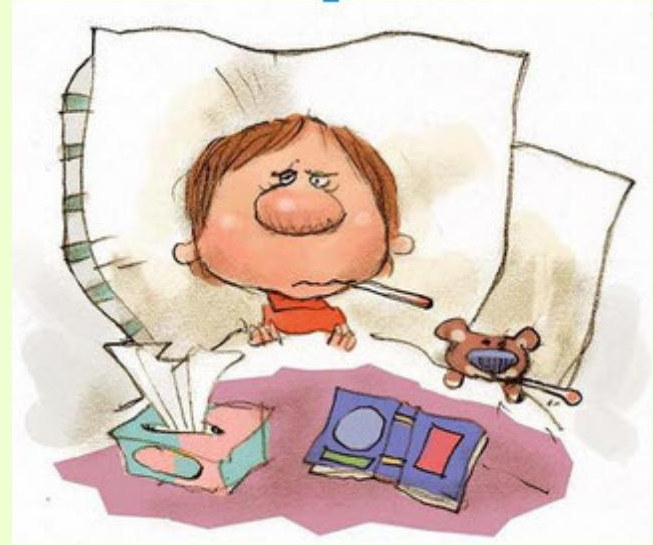
Susceptibility

the fact that someone can easily be influenced

Syn: vulnerability, sensitivity, openness, responsiveness

Atn: insensitive, unlikely, unresponsive
unsusceptible, resistant

Exp: Lack of exercise increases susceptibility to disease



Reinforce

strengthen especially with additional material.

Syn: boost, fortify, increase, emphasize

Atn: decrease, diminish, discourage, lessen, let down

Exp: The captain sent out another squad to **reinforce** the troops.
