SCUPPER



Antonyms: encourage, promote, stimulate, foster, nurture.



Meaning: prevent from working or succeeding

The plans for a highway were **scuppered** by a public inquiry

Synonyms: Ruin, Wreck, Damage, Spoil. Smash

UNFATHOMABLE

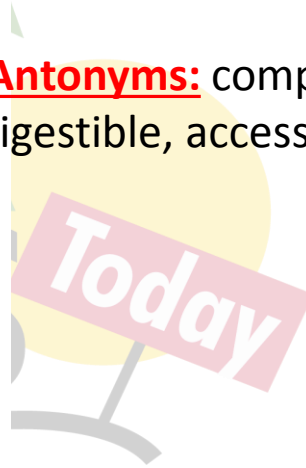


Meaning: incapable of being fully explored or understood

The child looked at the physics book and found the work completely **unfathomable**.

Synonyms: Incalculable, Obscure, Secretive, Inscrutable

Antonyms: comprehensible, penetrable, digestible, accessible;



SPURN



Meaning: reject with disdain or contempt.

If you decide to spurn this opportunity, you may always regret your decision.

Synonyms: Refuse, Decline, Rebuff, Scorn, Disown

Antonyms: accept, approve, agree, honour, adore



INEXORABLE



Meaning: impossible to stop or prevent

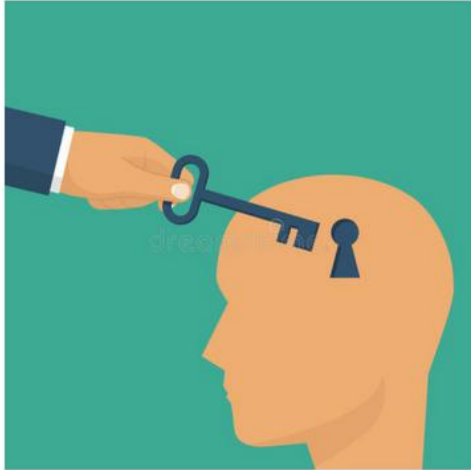
Of course, the public is enraged by the **inexorable** rise in gas prices.

Synonyms: Relentless, Unavoidable, Inevitable

Antonyms: flexible, avoidable, merciful



ENTRENCHED

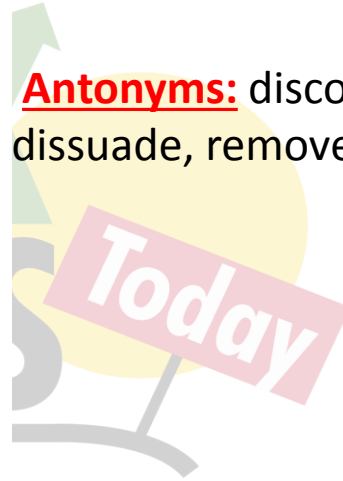


Meaning: so fixed or have existed for so long that they cannot be changed:

It's very difficult to change attitudes that have become so deeply entrenched over the years

Synonyms: Deep-rooted, Inelastic, Incurable

Antonyms: discourage, weaken, dissuade, removed
