Overt

done or shown in an obvious way and not secret

Syn: noticeable, apparent, undisguised, unconcealed, conspicuous

Ant: unclear, concealed, hidden, private

Exp: As soon as Beverly saw the dog's **overt** aggression, she stood in front of her daughter to protect her.



Meticulous

showing great attention to detail; very careful and precise.

Syn: careful, diligent, ultra-careful, scrupulous, conscientious

Atn: careless, imprecise, aimless, unsystematic

Exp: Although Jennifer was a **meticulous** student, she still had difficulty organizing her essay.




Nexus

a central or focal point

Syn: center, connection, link, union,
network

Atn: detachment, disunion, division,
separation, break

Exp: The amusement park district is the
nexus of the city's attractions.



Succinct

something briefly and clearly expressed

Syn: concise, summary, short, brief, compact, condensed

Atn: lengthy, long-winded, verbose

Exp: Everyone was happy when the politician made a **succinct** speech that did not take all evening.



Espouse

adopt or support

Syn: embrace, accept, approve, encourage

Atn: reject, disallow, refuse, oppose

Exp: These students tend to **espouse** very distinct world views.
