Ubiquitous

present, appearing, or found everywhere.

Syn: omnipresent, ever-present, pervasive, universal, worldwide

Atn: rare, scarce, negligible, sparse

Exp: He aims to make his product **ubiquitous** by selling it internationally.



Amplify

enlarge upon or add detail

Syn: increase, boost, magnify, intensify, escalate, expand

Atn: decrease, compress, condense, weaken, diminish, reduce

Exp: I refuse to watch TV anymore because of how news stations amplify bad news in a way that causes unnecessary anxiety.



Insinuate

to imply or suggest that something negative is true

Syn:: imply, suggest, hint, intimate, whisper, indicate,

Atn: conceal, hide, leave alone withhold

Exp: Are you trying to **insinuate** I did not complete my homework on my own?




Proliferate

increase rapidly in number; multiply.

Syn: multipl, mushroom, burgeon, escalate,

Atn: decrease, , lessen, shrink, decline, fall off

Exp: As problems with the business continued to **proliferate**, Edward decided to retire.



Inadvertent

not resulting from or achieved through deliberate planning.

Syn: unintentional, unintended, accidental, unpremeditated, unplanned

Atn: careful, cautious, intentional, advertent, attentive, deliberate, planned



Exp: After working on it for five hours, thank goodness I caught myself before I made an **inadvertent** deletion of the whole report.
