very loud, or full of confusion, change, or uncertainty

Syn: deafening, thunderous, stormy, turbulent, violent, volatile

Atn: peaceful, uneventful, orderly, calm, soft

Exp: After the **tumultuous** events of 1990, Europe was completely transformed



Formidable

inspiring fear or respect through being impressively large, powerful

- Syn: frightening, terrifying, disturbing, , dreadful,
- Atn: feeble, friendly, nice, harmless, unthreatening
- Exp: She is a **formidable** figure who commands a great deal of respect.





impair the quality or appearance of

Syn: spoil, ruin, blemish, scar, mutilate, deface

Atn: create, adorn, embellish, repair, mend

Exp: Violence by the party activists has marred the election process



Reconciliation

the restoration of friendly relations

- Syn: reunion, resolution, settlement, rectification, amity, concord
- Atn: estrangement, alienation, feud, incompatibility
- Exp: If the **reconciliation** between the two Indian tribes takes place, there will finally be peace in the area.





not openly acknowledged or displayed.

- Syn: secret, furtive, clandestine, surreptitious, stealthy
- Atn: open, public, overt, unconcealed, candid
- Exp: As an investigator, John often uses covert surveillance methods to follow his suspects without being seen.
