CWUR'S WORLD UNIVERSITY RANKINGS 2021-22

Current Context: The Centre for World University Rankings (CWUR) released World University rankings for 2021-22.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The list is topped by Harvard University.
- The second and third ranks are marked by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) and Stanford University respectively.
- From Indian Institutes, the list is topped by IIM Ahmedabad. It is placed at world rank 415th.
- The IISc Bangalore is at 459th position and the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research is at 543rd position.
- **The parameters considered for rankings are:** Quality of Education, Alumni Employment, Faculty Quality and Performance in Research.

'AMBITAG'--- IIT ROPAR

Current Context: The IIT Ropar has developed India's first indigenous temperature data logger named 'AmbiTAG' for cold chain management.

KEY FACTS

- It is India's first-of-its-kind IoT based device that will allow secure transportation of vaccines, blood and body organs, perishable products (food and dairy), etc.
- The 'AmbiTAG' also attains the objective of 'Atma Nirbhar Bharat'.
- The 'AmbiTAG' records real-time ambient temperature during the transportation of perishable products, vaccines and even body organs and blood.
- The temperature recorded by it further helps to know whether the product which is being transported from anywhere in the world is still usable or perished because of temperature variation.
- The temperature variation for such products is vital as it decides its quality and life; particularly critical for vaccines including the Covid-19 vaccine.
- Therefore, the 'AmbiTAG' continuously records the temperature of its immediate surroundings from 40 to +80 degrees in any time zone for a full 90 days on a single charge.
- The 'AmbiTAG' is developed by IIT Ropar's Technology Innovation Hub named AWaDH (Agriculture and Water Technology Development Hub) and its Startup ScratchNest.

5TH BRICS WORKING GROUP MEET ON HPC AND ICT

Current Context: South Africa hosted the 5th BRICS Working Group Meeting on High-Performance Computing (HPC) and Information Communication Technology (ICT) in an online manner.

KEY POINTS

- Around 50 dignitaries from BRICS nations participated in the meet.
- India was represented by Sanjeev Kumar Varshney, Advisor DST.
- The dignitaries discussed the usage of HPC and AI to tackle pandemic COVID-19 and to use it in sustainable developmental projects.
- They assured to cooperate with each other to use HPC technologies for weather-climate-environment based applications.
- India discussed the development of supercomputers by C-DAC under National Supercomputing Mission. This is in order to develop and deploy a user-friendly early warning system for flood prediction.
- China proposed AI+HPC+5G- based digital twin platform and an open-source ecosystem.
- Brazil and South Africa proposed the flagship project on Digital Earth.

Current Context: The Government of Goa established 'Goa Institution for Future Transformation (GIFT)'.

DETAILS

- The GIFT is on the line of Think Tank NITI Aayog.
- It will perform the role of assisting, advising ad guiding the government to frame the policies and implement them.
- GIFT will also monitor sustainable development goals and will evaluate various developmental plans, programmes and schemes.
- It will be mentioned under Article 309 of the Indian Constitution to attain autonomy.
- The GIFT will also represent as knowledge hub Goa, which will work to showcase best practices to attain sustainable development of the State.

NCPCR LAUNCHED 'BAL SWARAJ' PORTAL

Current Context: The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) launched the 'Bal Swaraj' portal.

ABOUT

- The 'Bal Swaraj' is basically an online tracking portal, which tracks and monitors children who lost either or both parents due to coronavirus.
- The 'Bal Swaraj' consist of a link named 'COVID Care' which allows the officers to upload the data about such children who are in need to be taken care.
- The portal monitors the children affected by COVID-19 right from their production before the Child Welfare Committee (CWC), to the restoration of the children to their parent, guardian, or relative, and its subsequent follow-up.
- Also, the commission will be able to access data on whether the child is getting his/her entitlements, benefits, and entitled monetary gains, through the data filled in the portal by the District officers and State officers for each child.
- Therefore, the commission will get an idea of whether the child has been produced before the CWC and if the orders are being passed for him/her.
- Also, the commission will get to know whether the state needs any financial support to deliver the benefits of the schemes particular developed for children.

RDSO-1ST STANDARDS BODY TO JOIN THE 'ONE NATION, ONE STANDARD' SCHEME

Current Context: The Research Design and Standards Organisation (RDSO) has become the first standards body in India to join the 'One Nation, One Standard' scheme of the central government.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The RDSO works to set standards for the Indian Railway Sector.
- Thus now onwards, the RDSO will be recognised as a 'Standard Developing Organisation' by the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), for the tenure of 3 years.
- The 'One Nation, One Standard' scheme is implemented by the BIS.
- The BIS and RDSO will now jointly set the parameters for quality goods and services for the Railways.

'ASIA PACIFIC PUBLIC SECTOR CYBER SECURITY EXECUTIVE COUNCIL'

Current Context: Microsoft launched the 'Asia Pacific Public Sector Cyber Security Executive Council'.

KEY POINTS

- The aim behind this council is to develop a strong communications channel to address cyber threats and share best practices to tackle cyber crimes and threats across the globe.
- The council will be comprised of policymakers and influencers from countries like Indonesia, Korea, Brunei, Malaysia, Singapore, the Philippines, and Thailand.
- The council will be supported by cybersecurity professionals.
- It will also lead to developing a partnership among public-private cybersecurity professions and organisations.
- The council will also help to promote a broader sharing of threat intelligence to be better positioned to respond in the event of attacks.
- The council will meet on a quarterly basis in order to share data and best practices to tackle cybercrimes and threats.

74TH WHA MEETING OF WHO

Current Context: The World Health Organisation (WHO) conducted the 74th edition of the World Health Assembly (WHA) meeting from its HQ in Geneva, Switzerland.

KEY FACTS

- The theme for the meeting was: 'Ending this pandemic, preventing the next: building together a healthier, safer and fairer world.'
- The President for 74th WHA was Mrs Dechen Wangmo, Health Minister of Bhutan.
- The dignitaries have decided to set the target of achieving at least 10% population of all countries to be vaccinated by Sep 2021 and at least 30% by Dec 2021.
- At the meeting, the 30th of Jan was adopted as 'World Neglected Tropical Diseases Day'.

INDIA'S GDP TO BE AT 7.9% FOR FY22—SBI ECOWRAP

Current Context: The SBI economists has revised India's GDP projections in its 'Ecowrap' report.

- As per the SBI Ecowrap report, India's GDP to be at 7.9% for FY22.
- Earlier it had projected India's GDP to be at 10.4%.
- The reason behind this revised projection is the second wave of the pandemic which has hit the nation in a severe manner, thereby leading to the lockdown situation in the country.
- Also, the report estimates, 'W-shaped' recovery in FY22. Earlier it was 'V-shaped' recovery for the same.

'SWASTIIK' TECHNOLOGY-BY CSIR-NCL, PUNE

Current Context: The CSIR-National Chemical Laboratory (CSIR-NCL), Pune has launched a new technology called 'SWASTIIK'.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The 'SWASTIIK' technology uses natural oils to disinfect water.
- The technology boils liquid as a result of pressure reduction or cavitation. It makes use of natural oils with antimicrobial properties to disinfect water.
- The other techniques to disinfect water makes use of chemical such as chlorination which include the formation of harmful or carcinogenic by-products. Therefore, the 'SWASTIIK' technology is safe to disinfect water.
- The technology comes against the backdrop of the National Jal Jeevan Mission (NJJM) and has issued an advisory to states and Union territories to monitor and survey water quality to ensure potable water during the second wave of the pandemic in India.
- The technology was developed by Scientist Dr V.M. Bhandari and his group at CSIR-NCL Pune. They
 received the support from Water Technology Initiative of the department of science and technology
 (DST).
- The 'SWASTIIK' technology can eliminate harmful bacteria, including antibiotic-resistant strains, economically. THE technology makes use of hydrodynamic cavitation and combines chemistry, biology, and chemical engineering approaches along with natural resources in the form of natural oils and plant extracts.

UNION CABINET APPROVED MOC BETWEEN INDIA AND JAPAN

Current Context: The Union Cabinet chaired by PM Modi approved the Memorandum of Cooperation (MoC) between India and Japan.

KEY POINTS

- The MoC was approved in the sector of Sustainable Urban Development.
- The MoC was signed between the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, India, and the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport, and Tourism, Japan.
- The MoC between both nations will promote deep, long-term, and strong bilateral cooperation in the sector of Sustainable Urban Development.

- Due to the MoC, the cooperation in the areas like urban planning, affordable housing (including rental housing), smart cities development, sewerage, and water waste management, urban flood management, Transit-Oriented Development, Intelligent transport management system, Disaster Resilient Development, multimodal integration will take place.
- The MoC was signed for 5 years and will be renewed after 5 years.

AGRICULTURE MINISTER LAUNCHED HORTICULTURE CLUSTER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Current Context: The Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, Narendra Singh Tomar launched the Horticulture Cluster Development Programme (CDP).

KEY FACTS

- The Horticulture CDP was launched to ensure the growth of the activities horticulture sector are in a proper manner or not.
- The programme will be executed in pilot phases and initially, 12 horticulture clusters out of the total 53 clusters are selected for the programme.
- The Horticulture CDP will be implemented by the National Horticulture Board (NHB) of the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare.
- It will work to develop identified horticulture clusters so that they can be represented at the global level.
- To uplift the horticulture sector, the programme leverage geographical specialization and promote integrated and market-led development of clusters.
- The programme will address the issues related to pre-production, production, post-production, harvest management, logistics, branding and marketing.
- The clusters of the pilot phase include Shopian (J&K) and Kinnaur (H.P.) for Apple, Lucknow (U.P.), Kutch (Gujarat) and Mahbubnagar (Telangana) for Mango, Anantpur (A.P.) and Theni (T.N.) for Banana, Nasik (Maharashtra) for Grapes, Siphahijala (Tripura) for Pineapple, Solapur (Maharashtra) and Chitradurga (Karnataka) for Pomegranate and West Jaintia Hills (Meghalaya) for Turmeric.
- These clusters will be implemented through Cluster Development Agencies (CDAs) which are appointed on the recommendations of the respective State/UT Government.

RBI ANNOUNCED FPI INVESTMENT LIMITS IN G-SECS AND SDLS

Current Context: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced that the limits for Foreign Portfolio Investors (FPI) investment in government securities (G-secs) for the current fiscal year and State Development Loans

(SDLs) will be unchanged i.e. will be at 6% and 2% respectively, of outstanding stocks of securities for 2021-22.

DETAILS

- The allocation of incremental changes in the G-sec limit over the two sub-categories of 'General' and 'Long-term' will be retained at 50:50 for FY 2021-22.
- The overall increase in limits for SDLs are added to the 'General' sub-category of SDLs.
- As of 31st March 2021, the current FPI limit in G-Sec General, G-Sec Long Term, SDL General, SDL Long Term, and Corporate Bonds, was Rs 9,54,280 crore.
- In debt instruments for April 2021- Sep 2021, the revised FPI investment limit was at Rs 10,14,957crore and for Oct 2021-March 2022 is Rs 10,75,67 crore.

- The central bank has projected India's GDP growth to be at 9.5% for the FY2021-22. Earlier it had projected India's GDP to be at 10.5% for the same fiscal year. But due to the second wave of pandemic and its impact on the economy, the RBI has reduced the GDP forecast for India.
- Also, the India's GDP contracted at -7.3% for FY21.
- Also, the projection for Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation is at 5.1% for FY 2021-22.
- RBI Governor announced that G-SAP 2.0 worth Rs 1.2 lakh crore will be taken in the second quarter of FY22 to support the market.

CSE'S STATE OF INDIA'S ENVIRONMENT REPORT 2021

Current Context: The State of India's Environment Report 2021 was released. It was released by the Centre for Science and Environment (CSE).

- As per the report, India is ranked at 117th position on the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) which were adopted as a part of the 2030 agenda by 193 United Nations member states in 2015.
- The SDG score for India is 61.9/100.
- Initially, India was at 115th position, thus India has dropped by 2 places from last year in the ranking.
- The reason behind the dropped position of India is major challenges like ending hunger and achieving food security (SDG 2), achieving gender equality (SDG 5) and building resilient infrastructure, promoting inclusive and sustainable industrialization and fostering innovation (SDG 9) remain in the country.
- India ranks below four South Asian countries namely Bhutan, Nepal, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh.

RBI IMPOSED PENALTY ON BOI AND PNB

Current Context: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a penalty on the Bank of India and Punjab National Bank.

DETAILS

- A penalty of a total of Rs 6 crore was imposed on the banks.
- The penalty was imposed for not following norms related to Frauds Classification and Reporting.
- The Bank of India has imposed a penalty of Rs 4 crore and Punjab National Bank has imposed a penalty of Rs 2 crore, thus totalling Rs 6 crore penalty.

- The RBI mentioned that the statutory Inspection for Supervisory Evaluation (ISE) of the Bank of India was conducted with reference to its financial position as of March 31, 2019. The bank had also conducted a review and submitted a Fraud Monitoring Report (FMR) dated January 1, 2019, pertaining to the detection of fraud in an account.
- After examining the reports related to the ISE and the FMR, it was observed non-compliance with the
 norms like a breach of stipulated transaction limits; delay in transfer of unclaimed balances to DEA
 Fund; delay in reporting fraud to RBI and sale of a fraudulent asset by Bank of India. For these reasons,
 the penalty was imposed on BoI.
- The RBI mentioned that the statutory ISE of Punjab National Bank was conducted with reference to its financial position as of March 31, 2018 (ISE 2018) and March 31, 2019 (ISE 2019).
- Thus by examining the risk assessment reports for ISE 2018 and 2019 it was revealed that PNB did not follow norms and was responsible for delay in reporting of frauds and not ensuring data accuracy and integrity while submitting data on the CRILC platform/ to RBI. For these reasons, the penalty was imposed on PNB

RBI CHANGED THE RULES REGARDING ATM CASH WITHDRAWALS

Current Context: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has made changes in the rules pertaining to the cash withdrawal from the Automated Teller Machine (ATM).

KEY FACTS

- The rules include higher charges on transactions beyond the free permissible limit, a new free ATM transaction limit and a rise in interchange fee.
- The rules were changed as per the recommendations of the committee setup under the Chairmanship of the Chief Executive, Indian Banks' Association. The committee was formed in June 2019. The role of the committee was to review ATM charges and fees with a particular focus on interchange structure for ATM transactions.
- The RBI has allowed a free cash withdrawal limit from its own bank. Due to this rule, customers will now be able to perform five free financial and non-financial transactions every month from their own bank ATMs.
- Also, ATM cardholders can perform three free financial and non-financial transactions in metro centres while five in the non-metro transaction from other bank ATMs.
- The banks are allowed by RBI to raise charges on ATM transactions beyond the free ATM transaction limit.
- The interchange fee amount is raised from Rs 15 to Rs 17 for financial transactions while from Rs 5 to Rs 6 for non-financial transactions, which will be effective from 1st August 2021.
- The customer of the bank will have to pay Rs 21 instead of Rs 20(currently) for each ATM cash withdrawal beyond the free transaction limit in effect from 1st Jan 2021.

- The enrolment of female students to pursue higher education has increased by 18.2%.
- The total enrolment for higher education was at 3.85 crores in 2019-20. Of the total, 49% constitutes female enrolments. Uttar Pradesh has topped for the highest enrolment by students. The second and third positions are marked by Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu respectively.
- The Gross Enrolment Ratio for 2019-20 was at 27.1%.
- The Gender Parity Index (GPI) was at 1.01 in 2019-20. The index reveals improvement in the relative access to higher education for females of eligible age group compared to males.
- The Pupil- Teacher Ratio in Higher Education was 26:1 in 2019-20. PTR is the number of students who attended school or university to the number of teachers in the institution.
- Around, 3.38 crore students enrolled for UG and PG level educational programmes. Also, 2.03 lakh students pursued PhD in 2019-20.
- The all India average College density was at 30. It indicates the number of colleges per lakh eligible population.

'JIVAN VAYU'--- IIT ROPAR

Current Context: The Indian Institute of Technology, Ropar developed a device named as 'Jivan Vayu'.

- The 'Jivan Vayu' is a substitute for CPAP (Continuous Positive Airway Pressure) machine.
- It can deliver high flow oxygen up to 60 Litres Per Minute (LPM).
- It can function without electricity. It is suitable for both kinds of oxygen generation units namely, O2 cylinders and oxygen pipelines in hospitals.
- It is basically designed for a 22mm CPAP closed-circuit tube and is customizable to the tube size.
- It is manufactured using 3D printing and was tested mechanically.
- The 'Jivan Vayu' is capable to deliver high flow oxygen (20–60 LPM) and can maintain a continuous positive pressure of up to 20 cm H2O.
- It maintains FiO2 of above 40% and PEEP (positive end-expiratory pressure) of 5-20 cm H2O.
- The device will prove beneficial during the pandemic period of COVID-19 especially when the power supply is a major concern for saving the lives of those who are on medical equipment like ventilators and oxygen concentrators.
- The device is developed by Dr Khushboo Rakha, Assistant Professor, Metallurgical and Materials Engineering. It was developed at the Advanced Materials and Design Lab of IIT Ropar.

- The mission will be executed for 5 years and the estimated cost for the mission is Rs 4077 crore which will be allocated in a phased manner.
- The estimated cost for the first phase for the 3 years (2021-2024) would be Rs.2823.4 crore.
- The 6 major components of Deep Ocean Mission are: (1) Development of Technologies for Deep Sea Mining, and Manned Submersible (2) Development of Ocean Climate Change Advisory Services (3) Technological innovations for exploration and conservation of deep-sea biodiversity (4) Deep Ocean Survey and Exploration (5) Energy and freshwater from the Ocean (6) Advanced Marine Station for Ocean Biology.
- The technologies which are required to perform deep sea mining are not commercially available and also possess strategic implications. Therefore, efforts will be made to indigenize technologies by collaborating with leading institutes and private industries.
- The research vessel which will be required to explore the Deep Ocean will be built in an Indian shipyard which will create employment opportunities.

Current Context: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) gave 'in-principle' approval to Centrum Financial Services Ltd (CFSL) to form a small finance bank (SFB), which will take over the beleaguered Punjab and Maharashtra Cooperative Bank (PMC Bank).

- During the first year, Rs 900 crore will be infused by the partners to start the business operations and acquire PMC Bank and during the second year, equity funding of Rs 900 crore will take place.

Current Context: The Reserve Bank of India issued guidelines on the distribution of dividends by Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs).

- The guidelines for the same were issued to have transparency and uniformity in the practice.
- The guidelines will be effective for the declaration of dividend from the profits of the financial year ending March 31, 2022, and onwards.
- The guidelines will be applicable to all the NBFCs which are under RBI.
- As per the minimum prudential requirements prescribed for declaration of dividend, the net NPA ratio of the NBFC concerned will be less than 6% in each of the last three years, including as at the close of the financial year for which the dividend is proposed to be declared.
- The NBFC should fulfil the regulatory capital requirement for each of the last three financial years, including the financial year for which the dividend is proposed.
- For the core investment company which supposes an NBFC, the maximum dividend payout ratio will be 60%. It will be 50% for other NBFCs. The dividend payout ratio is the ratio between the amount of the dividend payable in a year and the net profit as per the audited financial statements.

- And the proposed dividend will be the inclusion of both dividend on equity shares and compulsorily convertible preference shares eligible for inclusion in Tier 1 capital.
- The NBFCs are supposed to give a detailed report for dividend declared during the financial year to the RBI.

FM ANNOUNCED RS. 6,28,993 CRORE RELIEF PACKAGE AGAINST COVID-19

Current Context: Union Finance & Corporate Affairs Minister, Nirmala Sitharaman announced the 'Economic Relief from Pandemic' package of Rs 6,28,993 crore.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The package will support the Indian economy to fight the pandemic COVID-19.
- Under this package around 17 measures were announced by FM which are classified in 3 categories of (1) Economic Relief from Pandemic (2) Strengthening Public Health (3) Impetus for Growth and Employment
- (1) Economic Relief from Pandemic: In this category, 8 out of 17 relief measures were announced. The relief measures will provide economic relief to the Indians and Businesses affected by the pandemic with a major focus on the health, travel and tourism sector. Under this, Rs 1.10 lakh crore Loan Guarantee Scheme for COVID Affected sectors will be granted. It includes Rs 50,000 crore for the health sector and Rs 60,000 crore for other sectors like tourism. Additionally, Rs 1.5 lakh crore for Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) will also be offered under this category. This category also includes a new scheme called Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro Finance Institutions in which the amount per loan capped at Rs 1.25 lakh at an interest rate of MCLR (the minimum lending rate for a bank) plus 2% will be offered. The scheme will prove beneficial to 10,700 Regional Level Tourist Guides and to 1,000 Travel and Tourism Stakeholders (TTS). The category also grants free on a month tourist visa to 5 lakh tourists in which the total amount sanctioned is Rs 100 crore. The facility will be available till 31st March 2022 or till 5 lakh visas are issued, whichever is earlier.
- The category of 'Economic Relief from Pandemic' also describes an extension of Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Rozgar Yojana (ANBRY) from 30th June 2021 to 31st March 2022. It also offers additional Subsidies for DAP & P&K fertilizers. The nutrient based subsidy is increased to Rs 42,275 crore in FY 2021-22. Also, free food grains will be provided under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana (PMGKY) from May to Nov 2021 with the financial inclusion of Rs 93,869 crore.
- (2) Strengthening Public Health: In this category, 1 out of 17 relief measures was announced in which, Rs 23,220 crores will be allotted for public health with the major focus on children and paediatric care/paediatric beds.
- (3) Impetus for Growth and Employment: In this category, 8 out of 17 relief measures were announced. The Climate Resilient Special Traits Varieties will be released. There will be a total revival

of the North Eastern Regional Agricultural Marketing Corporation (NERAMAC). The category will offer additional support of Rs 33,000 crore to boost project exports through National Export Insurance Account (NEIA) for a tenure of 5 years. Also, Rs 88,000 crore will be provided through equity in Export Credit Guarantee Corporation (ECGC) over 5 years to Export Insurance Cover. To give major support for the 'Digital India' initiative, Rs. 19,041 crore will be sanctioned to provide broadband to each village through BharatNet PPP Model. The FM also announced to extend the tenure of the PLI Scheme for Large Scale Electronics Manufacturing by one more year i.e. till 2025-26. Also, Rs 3.03 lakh crore will be sanctioned for reform based Result-Linked Power Distribution Scheme. The category will give a streamlined and efficient process for PPP Projects and Asset Monetization.
