

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

TEMASEK TO INVEST 1,200 CR. IN MAHINDRA & MAHINDRA'S PASSENGER EV FIRM

- The investment by Temasek is seen as a vote of confidence in **Mahindra's EV strategy and vision**, as the company aims to become a global leader in electric SUVs.
- This investment will make Temasek one of the investors in MEAL, along with British International Investments (BII), which invested Rs 1,925 crore (\$258 million) in MEAL last year.

PNGRB & WORLD BANK PARTNERS TO DEVELOP ROADMAP

- NGRB is the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board, which is the regulator of the natural gas sector in India. The World Bank is an international financial institution that provides loans and grants to low- and middle-income countries for various development projects.
- The study will cover aspects such as mapping demand and supply of hydrogen, technical assessment of the existing pipeline network for its compatibility, commercial assessment of pipeline sector, identifying bottlenecks in policy and regulatory framework, and framing of roadmap till 2040 for expeditious implementation of hydrogen blending in India.



SWISS IMPACT INVESTOR SIGNS AGREEMENT WITH ELECTRONICA FINANCE

- The Pune-based non-banking finance company, which is part of the SRP Electronica group, will use the funding to finance energy-efficient machines and promote rooftop solar installation, managing director Shilpa Pophale told ET.
- It provides machine loans, business loans, loans against property, as well as working capital loan and loans to micro enterprises.

MULTILATERAL NAVAL EXERCISE MALABAR 2023

- The exercise aims to enhance interoperability, sea deterrence, and sea denial in order to ensure freedom of navigation in the Indo-Pacific region.
- It also provides an opportunity for the participating navies to learn from each other's best practices and enhance their maritime security capabilities.

INDIA IS THE LARGEST SOURCE OF HUMAN HAIR

- This is mainly due to the tradition of women offering their long hair in temples as a **sign of gratitude and devotion.**
- It can also provide employment opportunities and income for many people in India.

INDIA AND CHINA ARE SET TO HOLD THE 19TH ROUND OF CORPS COMMANDER TALKS

- The main agenda of the talks is to seek early disengagement of troops from the remaining friction points, such as Depsang Plains and Demchok, where both sides have a strong military presence.
- Since then, they have signed several agreements and mechanisms to maintain peace and stability along the Line of Actual Control (LAC), but the situation remains tense and unpredictable.

- On August 1, 2023, the British government officially acknowledged that the Islamic State group committed "acts of genocide" against the Yazidi people in 2014.
- China's internet watchdog, the Cyberspace
 Administration of China (CAC), has released draft guidelines to restrict internet usage by minors.
 According to the draft guidelines, minors would not be allowed to use most internet services on mobile devices from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m
- Cambodia's King Norodom Sihamoni has appointed former Prime minister Hun Sen's son Hun Manetas the new prime minister of the country.
- China has recently drafted rules for the use of facial recognition technology.
- The European Union has raised data privacy concerns over the proposed G20 MSME portal that India has proposed for the micro, small and medium enterprises
- India and China have agreed to resolve the remaining issues along the Line of Actual Control (LAC) in an "expeditious manner" and maintain peace and tranquility in the border areas
- Former US President Donald Trump has been indicted for scheming illegally to overturn his election loss in the 2020 election. This marks the third time he has been indicted on criminal charges.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi will be visiting Johannesburg, South Africa from August 22-24, 2023 to attend the 15th BRICS Summit at the invitation of H.E. Mr. Matamela Cyril Ramaphosa, President of the Republic of South Africa. This will be the first in-person BRICS Summit since 2019.
- Iran's Foreign Minister Hossein Amir-Abdollahian met Saudi Arabia's Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman (MBS) in Jeddah on Friday, August 18, 2023. This was the first visit to the kingdom since the Middle East rivals announced a surprise rapprochement.
- Russia's national space agency, Roscosmos, reported that their moon-bound Luna-25 spacecraft encountered an "abnormal situation" prior to entering the pre-landing orbit. The issue arose during a maneuver, preventing the specific parameters from being met.

NATIONAL NEWS

JHARKHAND CM LAUNCHES MOBILE APP

- The app is designed to help villagers and forest department officials to monitor the location and movement of elephants, so that they can take preventive measures to avoid any harm or damage.
- The app also provides information on elephant behaviour, habitat, and conservation efforts. The app is part of the government's initiative to protect the elephants and the people living near their habitats.

UNFPA & MP GOVT LAUNCH 'JUST ASK!' CHATBOT

- It's a great initiative to provide accurate and reliable information on social issues and sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR) among adolescents and young adults in India.
- The 'Just Ask!' chatbot is an Artificial Intelligence (AI) digital engagement platform that helps users learn about their SRHR in a safe, personalized, and non-judgmental way.
- The 'Just Ask!' chatbot aims to address the critical need for SRHR awareness among young people in India, who often face barriers such as stigma, myths, misinformation, and lack of access to quality services.

NATIONAL MISSION FOR CLEAN GANGA APPROVES 7 PROJECTS

- These projects are expected to improve the water quality and biodiversity of the Ganga basin, as well as enhance the livelihoods and well-being of the people living along the river.
- These projects will create new sewage treatment plants (STPs) and interception and diversion (I&D) works to prevent untreated wastewater from flowing into the river.

KERALA CM PINARAYI VIJAYAN LAUNCHES LEAP COWORKS

 LEAP stands for Launch, Empower, Accelerate, Prosper, and it aims to provide state-of-the-art infrastructure, workspaces, meeting rooms, highspeed internet, and other amenities for a productive work environment.



• LEAP also offers mentorship programmes, business development assistance, access to funding opportunities and expert guidance to the startups.

DGT PARTNERS WITH AMAZON WEB SERVICES

- This initiative will benefit students enrolled in institutions under the DGT, which is responsible for implementing long-term institutional skill training through its network of about 15,000 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) and 33 National Skill Training Institutes (NSTIs) across India.
- This initiative aims to enhance students' skills and make them more employable.

BHARAT DYNAMICS LIMITED HANDS OVER 1ST 'RADIO FREQUENCY SEEKER OF AKASH'

- The Radio Frequency (RF) Seeker is a critical and technology intensive subsystem used in Surface-to-Air Missiles and Air-to-Air Missiles for target tracking in the terminal phase.
- The RF Seeker can successfully make the new generation surface-to-air missiles, Akash NG, lock onto any enemy aircraft till it is destroyed.

ASSAM CM LAUNCHED AMRIT BRIKSHYA ANDOLAN APP

- The Amrit Brikshya Andolan app is a web portal and mobile application that aims to plant a total of one crore (10 million) commercially-viable saplings across the state by individuals from various walks of life on September 17, 2023.
- The Chief Minister also launched a **theme song for the Amrit Brikshya Andolan**, which is an **initiative to boost the state's green economy and fight against climate change.**

INDIA WON ITS FIRST GOLD MEDAL IN THE WORLD ARCHERY CHAMPIONSHIPS

- It was a historic moment for Indian archery, as they had never won a gold medal at the world championships before. Congratulations to the Indian team!
- India also won two more gold medals in the individual compound events on Saturday, August 5.

JYOTIRADITYA M. SCINDIA UNVEILED THE NEW LOGO OF THE NMDC

- The new logo, called NMDC 2.0, retains the blue cog symbolizing the mining cycle, representing the company's steadfastness and trust earned over the years.
- The Minister said that the new logo reflects NMDC's vision of becoming a global leader in mining and contributing to India's self-reliance and development.

MOHFW LAUNCHED E-CARE PORTAL

- The e-CARe Portal stands for e-Certificate for Authorization of Remains. It is a web-based application that allows the relatives or friends of the deceased to apply for a certificate online, without visiting any government office.
- The portal also provides information on the guidelines and protocols for handling and disposal of human remains, as well as the contact details of the nodal officers in each state and union territory.

NABARD SUPPORTS RAJASTHAN TO GET 5 GI TAG CERTIFICATION

- GI tags help to protect the authenticity and uniqueness of such products, as well as promote their economic and cultural value.
- The GI tags will help to preserve the intactness of the disappearing artworks, safeguard the traditional knowledge and cultural expressions of the state, enhance the product quality and market access, create awareness and strengthen the producer's capacity to enforce their rights, and empower the local communities by enhancing their income levels.

GRSE LAUNCHED NEERAKSHI, INDIA'S FIRST INDIGENOUS AUV

- Neerakshi is a Sanskrit word that means "eyes in the water" and it is a collaboration of Kolkata-based warshipmaker Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE) Ltd and MSME entity AEPL.
- It can be used for a variety of functions ranging from mine detection to mine disposal to underwater survey.

• It is also equipped with sensors and imaging systems to aid search-and-rescue missions.

MAHARASHTRA'S NEW AMRAVATI STATION

- The New Amravati station, which was inaugurated on August 8, 2023, has 12 women employees who handle its operations.
- The station also has a pink theme, with pink walls, pink benches, and pink signboards. The station aims to empower women and promote gender equality in the male-dominated railway sector.

CJI ANNOUNCES LAUNCH OF 'SUSWAGATAM' PORTAL

- The **portal allows users to choose different validity periods for their e-passes**, depending on their needs and police clearance certificates.
- The portal also provides role-based secure logins for different types of users where they can upload their proof of identity and capture their live photo during the registration process.

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA MODI LAYS FOUNDATION OF SANT RAVIDAS TEMPLE

- The temple-cum-memorial, named as Shiromani Gurudev Shri Ravidas ji Memorial, will be built at a cost of Rs. 100 crore at Badtuma village, about 40 km from Sagar city. The memorial will have a grand temple in Nagar style, a museum, a library, a Sangat hall, a Jal Kund, and a Bhakt Niwas.
- The temple will also **display the teachings and works of Sant Ravidas,** who was a 15th-century saint and a prominent figure in the Bhakti movement.

DPIIT AND MORD LAUNCHED ODOP WALL

- ODOP stands for One District One Product, a program that aims to identify and showcase one unique product from each district of the country.
- The ODOP Wall at SARAS Ajeevika Store features product tagging and story cards that help consumers learn more about the origin and significance of the product.

GOVERNMENT TO OPEN 25000 JAN AUSHADHI KENDRAS

- The government's initiative to open 25000 Jan Aushadhi Kendras is a commendable step to make medicines available at affordable prices for the common people.
- According to the Pharmaceuticals & Medical Devices Bureau of India, the vision of the scheme is to bring down the healthcare budget of every citizen of India through providing "Quality Generic Medicines at Affordable Prices".

AIR INDIA UNVEILS NEW LOGO 'THE VISTA' AT REBRANDING EVENT

- The new logo is a modern design with golden, red and purple colors, inspired by the peak of the gold window frame that signifies limitless possibilities, progressiveness, and the airline's bold, confident outlook for the future.
- The new logo also incorporates the traditional 'jharokha' design found on all windows of all current aircraft. The rebranding is part of Air India's transformation journey under the Tata Group, which acquired the airline in early 2021.
- The rest of the plane uses the red and gold color scheme, with red wingtips and gold accents on the belly.

CENTRE AND WHO TO LAUNCH GLOBAL INITIATIVE ON DIGITAL HEALTH

- Global Initiative on Digital Health (GIDH), which is a joint effort by India and the World Health Organization (WHO) to improve health outcomes and achieve universal health coverage through digital technologies.
- The initiative aims to facilitate the implementation of the Global Strategy on Digital Health 2020–2025, which was adopted by the WHO Member States in 2020.

KERALA GOVT LAUNCHES 'ATHIDHI PORTAL'

- The Kerala government has launched a new web portal called 'Athidhi Portal' to register migrant workers in the state and provide them with a unique identification system.
- The portal aims to collect information about the workers and ensure that they have social security, health insurance, and other benefits.





INDIA'S FIRST 3D-PRINTED POST OFFICE BUILDING INAUGURATED

- It's a **remarkable achievement** that showcases the country's **innovation and progress.**
- The post office building was constructed using 3d concrete printing technology, which is a fully automated process that uses a robotic printer to deposit concrete layer by layer as per the approved design.

HEALTH MINISTER MANSUKH MANDAVIYA LAUNCHED THE GLOBAL INITIATIVE

- The GIDH is a network of stakeholders organized by the World Health Organization (WHO) to facilitate the implementation of the Global Strategy on Digital Health 2020–2025.
- The initiative aims to support countries in their digital health transformation by providing technical assistance, quality assurance, and resource mobilization.

NATIONAL NEWS- ONE LINER

- The Centre for Development of Avanced Computing (CDAC) has collaborated with Arm, a UK-based semiconductor IP company, to expand semiconductor support under the Design Linked Incentive Scheme (DLI) and foster the growth of the sector in India.
- The Jalesar Dhatu Shilp (metal craft), Goa Mankurad mango, Goan Bebinca, Udaipur Koftgari metal craft, Bikaner Kashidakari craft, Jodhpur Bandhej craft and Bikaner Usta Kala craft were given the Geographical Indication (GI) tag.
- The Supreme Court of India has published new guidelines for the designation of senior advocates practicing mainly in the Apex Court.
- The Indian government has introduced a new Ayush visa category for foreign nationals seeking treatment under Indian systems of medicine, including Ayurveda, wellness, and Yoga.
- On August 3, 2023, the Union Minister Dharmendra Pradhan, Ministry of Education (MoE), and Union Minister Dr. Subrahmanyam Jaishankar, Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) jointly launched Study in India (SII) Portal which is an integrated one-stop solution for international student registration and visa application process.

- On Wednesday, 26th July, 2023, an MoU was signed between Prof. Jon Paul Rodríguez, Chair—IUCN SSC and Mr. Vivek Menon, Executive Director, Wildlife Trust of India to set up the first-ever regional Center for Species Survival (CSS) in India.
- India has handed over INR 450 million in advance to Sri Lanka to fund its unique digital identity project.
- Postal Life Insurance (PLI) has launched a new initiative called "Direct Incentive Disbursement" for its sales force.
- Dhaksha Unmanned Systems, a subsidiary of Agri solutions provider Coromandel International, has won an order from the Indian Army for the supply of 200 medium-altitude logistics drones and accessories.
- The **CBI Academy in Ghaziabad**, India joined the Interpol Global Academy Network as its **10th member through a virtual signing ceremony.**
- On Friday, August 11, 2023, Union Home Minister Amit Shah introduced three bills in the Lok Sabha to replace the Indian Penal Code (IPC), Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.PC) and the Indian Evidence Act (IEA), which are British-era laws.
- The Union Health Minister Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya inaugurated the second phase of the annual Nationwide Mass Drug Administration (MDA) initiative for Lymphatic Filariasis on August 10, 2023.
- Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), NITI Aayog in collaboration with the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and Navars Edutech successfully launched the National Space Innovation Challenge 2023 (NSIC 2023)
- Karnataka Deputy Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar announced on Tuesday, August 15, 2023, that Karnataka would release 10 tmcft of Cauvery river water to the neighboring Tamil Nadu.
- Union Home Minister Amit Shah was on a two-day visit to his home state Gujarat on May 20 and 21, 2023. During his visit, he dedicated projects worth Rs 800 crore to the public and attended the inauguration of Samast Modi Samaj's Rashtriya Mahasammelan.
- India's first Unmanned Aerial Systems (Drone)
 Common Testing Centre under the Defence Testing
 Infrastructure Scheme (DTIS) will be established in
 Tamil Nadu.
- President Droupadi Murmu visited West Bengal on August 17, 2023. During her one-day visit to Kolkata,



the President launched the 'My Bengal, Addiction Free Bengal' Campaign under the 'Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyan', organized by Brahma Kumaris at Raj Bhavan, Kolkata.

- The Supreme Court of India refused to stay the uploading of data collected in the recently concluded Bihar caste-based survey.
- The Rajya Sabha Chairman, Jagdeep Dhankar, has referred three proposed bills to the Standing Committee on Home Affairs for examination. These bills seek to replace British-era criminal laws and the Rajya Sabha has asked the Standing Committee to submit its report within three months.
- On 12th August 2023, President Droupadi Murmu gave assent to four bills including the Digital Personal Data Protection Bill 2023, the Registration of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Bill 2023, the Jan Vishwas (Amendment of Provisions) Bill 2023, and the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (Amendment) Bill 2023.
- The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) has developed an open-source software called the National Carbon Registry, which allows countries to effectively manage national data and processes for trading carbon credits.
- India's first long-range revolver 'Prabal' was launched by the state-owned enterprise Advanced Weapons and Equipment India (AWEIL).
- Union Minister Jitendra Singh unveiled a new variety of lotus flower with 108 petals, named 'Namoh 108'.

BANKING

ADB & GOI SIGNED USD 200 MILLION LOAN AGREEMENT

- The loan is an additional financing for the ongoing Rajasthan Secondary Towns Development Sector Project, which aims to improve water supply and sanitation systems, enhance urban resilience, and promote heritage living in selected towns.
- It will also help preserve the cultural and historical heritage of the towns by rehabilitating water structures and heritage buildings with nature-based solutions.

PAYTM LAUNCHES 2 NEW DEVICES

- These devices are called Paytm Pocket Soundbox and Paytm Music Soundbox, and they are both 4G enabled and offer instant audio payment alerts.
- Both devices are made in India and follow a subscription model. The rent for them ranges from INR 1 to INR 150 per month, depending on the merchant's transaction volume.
- Paytm claims that these devices will help small shops and merchants to increase their customer satisfaction and trust.

LIC MF COMPLETES MERGER OF IDBI MF SCHEMES

- The merger was effective from July 29, 2023. With the completion of the merger, out of 20 schemes of IDBI MF, 10 were merged with similar schemes of LIC MF and the remaining 10 were taken over by LIC MF on standalone basis, which took its total scheme count to 38.
- With this merger, investors who had invested in IDBI MF schemes, got access to LIC MF's diversified basket of product offerings covering equity, debt, hybrid, solution oriented themes, ETF and Index funds1.

CRED LAUNCHED RUPAY CREDIT CARD-BASED UPI PAYMENTS

- This feature allows CRED members to use their RuPay credit cards to make payments via UPI by scanning any UPI QR code or entering the merchant UPI ID.
- This is a convenient and secure way to use credit cards for day-to-day expenses and also enjoy exclusive benefits, offers, and rewards from CRED and RuPay.

STATE BANK OF INDIA FILES INSOLVENCY PLEA AGAINST MUMBAI METRO ONE

- MMOPL is a joint venture between the Mumbai Metropolitan Regional Development Authority (MMRDA) and Reliance Infrastructure (RInfra), which operates the Versova-Andheri-Ghatkopar metro line in Mumbai.
- The outcome of the NCLT's decision will determine the impact on MMOPL's financial stability and operations moving forward.



AXIS BANK PARTNERS WITH KIWI TO SUPPORT 'CREDIT ON UPI'

- The users can enjoy the benefits of credit card rewards, while experiencing the convenience of UPI's fast and secure payment.
- The partnership aims to promote digital payments and enhance financial inclusion in India.
- Kiwi's goal is to enable one million users to access credit cards on UPI over the next 18 months by forging additional banking partnerships.

INDIA FIRST LIFE INSURANCE LAUNCHES 'GUARANTEE OF LIFE DREAMS(G.O.L.D)'

- This is a product that offers regular long-term income to the policyholders, with flexible premium paying terms and three income options.
- The plan offers three income options: immediate, intermediate, and deferred. The immediate option provides regular income from the end of the first policy year till maturity..


GOVERNMENT SCHEMES
