MINISTRY OF DEFENSE

1. SIGNS CONTRACT WITH BEL

- Ministry of Defense signed a contract between Bharat Electronics Limited Bengaluru and Hyderabad for the supply of Advanced Electronic Warfare Suite for Fighter Aircraft.
- They also will supply suite for Instrumented Electronic Warfare Range for the Indian Air Force.
- The Cost estimated for this contract is Rs. 3102 Crore.

2. FAST TRACK PATROL VESSELS

- Ministry of Defense signed a contract with Goa Shipyard Limited (GSL) to build 8 fast patrol vessels for Indian Coast Guard.
- The cost of this contract is Rs. 473 Crore.

3. SIGNS CONTRACT WITH L & T

- Ministry of Defense signs contract with L&T for Multi-purpose Vessels for Indian Navy.
- The contract budge is Rs. 887 Crores.
- This contract is signed under "Buy-Indian" Category.

MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE

1. TB CASES INCREASES IN INDIA

- TB Cases has increased in India to 19% for the year 2021.
- The report was submitted by the National TB Prevalence Survey in India 2019-21.
- Delhi has topped the TB Prevalence among India.

2. BRICS VACCINE R&D CENTRE

- BRICS Vaccine R&D Centre was launched by Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya.
- It also has a workshop on Vaccine cooperation through a video-conference in New Delhi.
- India plans to offer its robust vaccine manufacturing industry for developing vaccines in BRICS countries.

PRESIDENT

JAL SHAKTI ABHIYAN

- President of India Ram Nath Kovind Launched Jal Shakti Abhiyan.
- The theme is "Catch the Rain 2022".
- This year Jal Shakti Abhiyan will focus on springshed development, catchment area augmentation and gender mainstreaming.

MINISTRY OF MINES

MOU BETWEEN INDIA AND AUSTRALIA

- Ministry of Mines under Government of India signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between India and Australia for joint exploration of Lithium and Cobalt.
- Both the Government has committed to invest USD \$6 million to explore these minerals for next 6 months.

MINISTRY OF TELECOMMUNICATION

RELEASES TEC REPORT

- Telecommunication Engineering Centre (TEC) report had released by K. Rajaraman, Secretary of the Department of Telecommunication.
- The reports mainly focus on the hassle free rollout of 5G services.
- They also concentrate on the development of a standardized ecosystem for Smart cities in India.
- This report is released by the Respective divisions of Telecommunication Engineering Centre.

MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION

1. WINGS INDIA 2022

- Wings India 2022 is a Asia's Largest Event on Civil Aviation held on March 24-27, 2022.
- It was held in Hyderabad, Telangana.
- Theme of this event was "India@75: New Horizon for Aviation Industry"

2. 220 NEW AIRPORTS

- Government of India has targeted to create 220 new Airports in India by 2025.
- The government also planned to develop 15 new pilot training schools.

MINISTRY OF JAL SHAKTI

SUJLAM 2.0

- Union Minister of Jal Shakti, Gajendra Singh Shekhawat launches Sujalam 2.0 Campaign for greywater management.
- Greywater refers to domestic wastewater generated from households or office buildings from streams without fecal contamination.
- Government is expecting people cooperation to manage this kind of water.

MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY

1. INDIA-UAE TRADE PACT

- Union Minister Piyush Goyal signed Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) between India and the United Arab Emirates (UAE).
- This trade agreement will come into force on May 1, 2022.
- This bilateral trade agreement will boost trade to USD 100 Billion over a 5-year period.

2. EXTEND TIMELINE FOR CONVERTING DEBT INTO EQUITY

- Government of India extends the timeline for converting Debt into equity for startups to 10 years.
- Before this the time line for startups is 5 years.
- It is calculated from the day when initial convertible note was issued.

• This amendment was done by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade which comes under Ministry of Commerce and Industry.

3. GI TAG FOR HAND KNOTTED KASHMIRI CARPETS

- Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade has given GI tag for hand knotted Kashmiri Carpets.
- The registered carpets were certified starting from 2022.

4. NARASINGAPETTAI NAGASWARM GOT GI TAG

- Narasingapettai Nagaswarm from Thanjavur of Tamil Nadu got GI Tag.
- It was a Musical instrument and manufactured by Thanjavur Musical Instruments Workers Cooperative Cottage Industries Society Limited.

MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE IN INS SHIVAJI

- INS Shivaji is recognized in Centre of Excellence in the field of Marine Engineering.
- INS Shivaji has three premier institutions viz. Center of Marine Engineering and Technology (CMET), Centre of Excellence (CoE) and Nuclear, Biological and Chemical Defense (NBCD) School.

NITI AAYOG

1. EXPORT PREPAREDNESS INDEX 2021

- National Institution for Transforming India (NITI Aayog) in partnership with the Institute of Competitiveness to release the Export Preparedness Index 2021.
- Gujarat has retained the top position in the overall ranking with its total share in exports accounting for 20.83% as of 2020-2021.
- This index was released by Dr. Rajiv Kumar, Vice Chairman of NITI Aayog.

2. INDO-GERMAN DEVELOPMENT COOPERATION PROJECT

- This project is aimed to increase to help women become more active in the economy as entrepreneurs, elimination the gender based obstacles.
- Theme: Economic Empowerment of Women Entrepreneurs and Start-ups by women (Her & Now)

MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT

1. START-UP VILLAGE ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROGRAM

- Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is signed between Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship(IIE),
 Guwahati, Assam and Ministry of Rural Development.
- This is to promote entrepreneurship among rural youths.
- This is to create employment opportunities in rural India.

2. CAPTIVE EMPLOYER

- Under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana, initiative called Captive Employer was initiated.
- This initiative will assure sustainable placements for rural poor youth.
- Training will be given for minimum 576 hours to a maximum of 2304 hours of skilling.
- This is to bridge the gap between skills and employment opportunity.

MINISTRY OF AYUSH

MEDICINE CENTRE IN GUJARAT

- Government of India signed an agreement with the World Health Organization to set up the Global Center for Traditional Medicine in Jamnagar, Gujarat.
- The investment for this center is USD 250 million.
- Treatments like ancient practices such as acupuncture, ayurvedic medicine and herbal mixtures.

MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

DARE2ERAD TB

- Dr. Jitendra Singh launches Data driven research to eradicate TB.
- This mission name is Dare2eraD TB
- It is launched under the part of "STEP Up to End TB 2022".
- The aim is to reach the goal of TB free India by 2025.

MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS

SAI NCOE FOR MTB AND BMX

- India's first Mountain Terrain Biking(MTB) and Bicycle Motocross (BMX) centres to train athletes opened in India as Sport Authority of India(SAI) National Centre of Excellence(NCOE).
- It was opened in Shimla, Himachal Pradesh.

MINISTRY OF FINANCE

RS. 1 TRILLION INFRASTRUCTURE LENDING

- Government of India has set a target of Rs. 1 Trillion Infrastructure Lending for the "National Bank for Financial Infrastructure and Development" (NaBFID).
- This is to start sanctioning loans to the infrastructure sector in FY2023.
- Government of India has already infused Rs. 20,000 crore in NaBFID.

PRIME MINISTER

1. 2ND INDIA AUSTRALIA VIRTUAL SUMMIT 2022

- PM Narendra Modi and PM of Australia Scott Morrison hold the 2nd India Australia Virtual Summit 2022
- The main aim of the summit is to reaffirm the commitment of the India-Australia Comprehensive Strategic Partnership.
- Different MoU has been signed between India-Australia in telecom, mineral, defense program, etc.,
- Australian Government has infused Rs. 1500 crore to boost ties with India in the area of clean technologies and innovation.

2. 14TH INDIA-JAPAN ANNUAL SUMMIT

- 14th India-Japan Annual Summit held in New Delhi, India on March 19-20, 2022.
- Prime Minister of Japan Fumio Kishida, visited India in person.
- Both sided finalized 7 loans from Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) worth Rs. 20400 crores for projects in connectivity, water supply and sewerage, horticulture, etc.

MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

NAGALAND PAPERLESS STATE ASSEMBLY

- Nagaland becomes the first state in North East India to have paperless proceeding in the legislative state assembly.
- This is done under National e-Vidhan Application(NeVA).
- This operation is known as Ashta Lakshmi.
- Bihar Legislative Council is the first state in India to transit NeVA.

MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS

1. MOU FOR ISRAELIAN FERTILIZER SUPPLY

- Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed between Israel and India for fertilizer supply for 5 years.
- Muriate of Potash will be bought from Israel Chemical Limited to Indian Potash Limited.

2. LINEAR ALKYLBENZENE MANUFACTURING

- Tamilnadu Petroproducts Ltd (TPL) became World's First linear alkybenzene (LAB) manufacturing company to receive the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) certification.
- The certification is in line with the requirements of the Linear Alkyl Benzene (Quality Control) Order, 2021.

3. STRENGTHENING PHARMA INDUSTRY SCHEME

- Government releases norms for strengthening of pharma industry.
- The total financial outlay of Rs. 500 crore for the period of 5 years.
- The scheme will support and strengthen the existing pharma clusters and MSMEs.
- This will help India in becoming a global leader in Pharma sector.

MINISTRY OF EARTH SCIENCE

INDIA'S ARCTIC POLICY

- Dr. Jitendra Singh launched India's Arctic Policy in New Delhi.
- India is one of the 13 nations holding Observer status in the Arctic Council.
- This is understand the impact of climate change in Arctic and deepen's India's participation in climate, economic and energy security related issues.

MINISTRY OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES

1. MSME INNOVATIVE SCHEME

- Narayan Tatu Rane launched MSME Innovative Scheme.
- This scheme will contain incubation, design and Intellectual Property Rights.
- To launch this, MSME Idea Hackathon 2022 has been conducted.

2. CREDIT GUARANTEE SCHEME

- Government extends Rs. 20,000 crores subordinate debt for stressed MSME's till march 2023.
- This is to provide credit facilities to Special Mention Account and Non Performing Assets Account who are eligible for restructuring.

POLICY ADVOCACY ARM

- Power Foundation a society to act as the top policy advocacy arm for the power and allied sectors.
- This can help in developing business ideas and solutions for India's Energy transition journey.

• The Director General of this arm is Sanjiv Nandan Sahai, former Power Secretary.

MINISTRY OF NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY

SMART GRID KNOWLEDGE CENTRE

- India gets Virtual Smart Grid Knowledge Centre in Manesar.
- This is located within the Power Grid Corporation of India Limited, Manesar, Haryana.
- This is to demonstrate and advancement of frontier smart grid technologies.

MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS

1. MOTOR VEHICLE AGREEMENT

- Motor Vehicle Agreement is done between Bangladesh, India and Nepal.
- The MVA aims to boost regional trade and people-to-people connectivity by fostering greater subregional cooperation.
- The pending ratification of the MVA by Bhutan was finalized.

2. OPERATION GANGA

- Operation Ganga devises plan to evacuate 15,000 Indians from Ukraine.
- Air India flights has helped to reach India due to Russia-Ukraine War.

MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS

INDIA WATER PITCH

- India Water Pitch Pilot Scale Start up Challenge launched under AMRUT 2.0.
- This is to address challenges in the urban water sector, under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0 at the India water Pitch-Pilot Scale Start-up Conclave.
- The aim of this event is to push startups in the water sector.
- The champions who are chosen will receive funding support of Rs. 20 lakhs in three installments.

E-MARKETPLACE

- E-Marketplace is a digital platform to provide web and mobile app facilitators that connect customers and the service providers.
- This platform will support to get business opportunities from tourism.

• This platform is launched by Incredible India Tourist Facilitators (IITF) or Incredible India Tourist Guides (IITG).

MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE

13 MAJOR RIVERS THROUGH FORESTRY INTERVENTION

- Government of India has created a Detailed Project Reports (DPR) on Rejuvenation of 13 major rivers through forestry interventions.
- The budget outlay of the DPRs is Rs. 19,342.62 Crore.
- The target of the project is to create green cover expansion for upcoming 10 years and 20 years under Amrit Kaal.

MINISTRY OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS

MV RAM PRASAD BISMIL

- The longest Vessel MV Ram Prasad Bismil sailed on the river Brahmaputra.
- The motor vessel is 90-meter long heavy cargo movement which started from the Haldia Dock, Kolkata, West Bengal and reached Pandu Port, Guwahati Assam successfully.
- This is to barge operation between Kolkata to Guwahati via the Indo-Bangladesh Protocal Route.

NATIONAL RAIL PLAN

- Ministry of Railways has released National Rail Plan for India-2030.
- This is for development of a futuristic railway system by 2030.
- To do this vision project, 58 supercritical projects of a total length of 3750 km costing Rs. 39,663 crore and 68 Critical Projects of a total length of 6913 km costing Rs. 75,736 crore.

GREEN HYDROGEN CAR

- India's first Green Hydrogen Car is launched by Union Minister of Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari.
- This was powered by Hydrogen and designed by Toyota and named as Toyota Mirai.
- This is the first project in India to create a Green Hydrogen based ecosystem by raising awareness about Green Hydrogen and FCEV technology.

LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIP 2009

- Ministry of Corporate Affairs amended the Limited Liability Partnership 2009 on 4th March 2022.
- This is to address the concerns of entities facing bankruptcy proceedings.
- It primarily deals with solvency statements and certificates of truthfulness.

DONATE A PENSION
