RBI CIRCULARS: SEPTEMBER 2022

GUIDELINES ON DIGITAL LENDING

- These guidelines are applicable to digital lending extended by:
 - All Commercial Banks,
 - Primary (Urban) Co-operative Banks, State Co-operative Banks, District Central Cooperative Banks; and
 - Non-Banking Financial Companies (including Housing Finance Companies)

DEFINITIONS

- Annual Percentage Rate (APR): APR is the effective annualised rate charged to the borrower of a digital loan. APR shall be based on an all-inclusive cost and margin including cost of funds, credit cost and operating cost, processing fee, verification charges, maintenance charges, etc., and exclude contingent charges like penal charges, late payment charges, etc.
- **Cooling off/look-up period:** A cooling off/ look-up period is the time window as determined by the Board of the RE which shall be given to borrowers for exiting digital loans, in case a borrower decides not to continue with the loan.



- **Digital Lending:** A remote and automated lending process, largely by use of seamless digital technologies for customer acquisition, credit assessment, loan approval, disbursement, recovery, and associated customer service.
- Digital Lending Apps/Platforms (DLAs): Mobile and web-based applications with user interface that facilitate digital lending services. DLAs will include apps of the Regulated Entities (REs) as well as those operated by Lending Service Providers (LSPs) engaged by REs for extending any credit facilitation services in conformity with extant outsourcing guidelines issued by the Reserve Bank.
- Lending Service Provider (LSP): An agent of a Regulated Entity who carries out one or more of lender's functions or part thereof in customer acquisition, underwriting support, pricing support, servicing, monitoring, recovery of specific loan or loan portfolio on behalf of REs in conformity with extant outsourcing guidelines issued by the Reserve Bank.
- According to the guidelines, all loan disbursals/repayments are to be executed only between the bank accounts of the borrower and the regulated entity (RE). REs need to ensure that the disbursal is not made to a third-party account, including the accounts of loan service providers (LSPs) and their digital lending apps (DLAs).
 - Any fees or charges payable to the LSPs are to be paid directly by REs and must not be charged by LSP to the borrower directly. Any penal interest/charges levied on borrowers must be based on the outstanding amount of the loan. Penal charges are to be disclosed upfront on an annualised basis to borrowers in the key fact statement (KFS).
 - The all-inclusive cost of digital loans for the borrower is to be disclosed upfront by REs and REs to provide a KFS to the borrower before contract execution for all digital lending products.
 - REs have to prominently publish the list of their DLAs, and LSPs engaged by them on their website and they must ensure that these LSPs/DLAs engaged by them do not

store the personal information of borrowers, except some basic minimal data.

- o LSP: Lending service provider
- o DLA: Digital lending apps

ENABLING BHARAT BILL PAYMENT SYSTEM (BBPS) TO PROCESS CROSS-BORDER INBOUND BILL PAYMENTS

 The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has allowed the Bharat Bill Payment System (BBPS) to process crossborder inbound payments to facilitate payment of utility bills by non-resident Indians (NRIs).

BANKING & FINANCIAL AWARENESS DIGEST SEPTEMBER 2022

INDIA RECORDS DOUBLE DIGIT GROWTH IN Q1 FY23

- India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) in the first quarter (April-June) of the fiscal year grew by 13.5% as per the data released by the National Statistical Office (NSO).
- The GDP grew at a rate of 20.1% during the same period last year.

- However, it is less than the estimation made by the RBI in the latest Monetary Policy Meeting where the RBI said that the GDP growth rate was likely to be around 16.2% in the first quarter of this fiscal year.
- India's fiscal deficit stood at Rs 3.41 lakh crore in April-July, accounting for 20.5% of the full-year target.
- A Fiscal Deficit indicates the total borrowing that is needed by the government.

MOODY'S CUTS INDIA'S GROWTH FORECAST

- Global rating agency Moody's on Thursday cut down India's economic growth for the current fiscal to 7.7% for the year 2022.
- Moody's earlier estimated India's GDP growth to be 8.8% in 2022.
- It cited the rising interest rates, uneven distribution of monsoon, and slowing global growth as reasons for the reduced projection.
- The global credit rating agency also lowered India's GDP forecast for **2023** to **5.2** percent from 5.4%.
- Credit rating is a numerical representation of the creditworthiness of an individual or a business in general terms or concerning a particular debt or financial obligation.
- Static part: Moody's was founded in 1909 with its headquarters in New York.

IMF APPROVES A LOAN TO SRI LANKA

- The International Monetary Fund (IMF) and Sri Lanka reached a preliminary agreement on a fouryear, \$2.9bn bailout package. The loan is aimed at restoring economic stability and debt sustainability for Sri Lanka.
- The 48-month program will introduce major tax reforms including broadening the tax base for corporate income tax and VAT and making the income tax more progressive.



- The announcement of the agreement comes at a time when the Headline Inflation rose to 64.3% in August 2022, while Food Inflation soared to 93.7%.
- Sri Lankan currency, the rupee, has also depreciated more than 44% against the USD since January 2022.
- Static part: The International Monetary Fund (IMF) is a United Nations agency with its headquarters in Washington DC. It primarily works to foster global monetary cooperation, secure financial stability, and facilitate international trade.

SEBI ISSUES GUIDELINES FOR STOCK BROKERS

- Capital market regulator, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) came out with guidelines for stock brokers providing algorithmic trading services.
- As per the SEBI, the objective of the issued guidelines is to prevent instances of "mis-selling".
- SEBI has warned the stock brokers who indulged in providing algorithmic-based trading facilities offered by unregulated platforms to remove any such content referring to past or future performance of such an algorithm within a week, i.e. by 9th September.
- The market regulatory board also directed stock exchanges to amend their bylaws rules and regulations for the implementation of SEBI's provisions in this regard.
- Algorithmic Trading refers to the use of advanced mathematical models that contain automated execution of the trade to generate results at a superfast pace.

RBI ISSUED GUIDELINES ON DIGITAL BANKING

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced the guidelines on digital lending.
- The Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) were given a deadline of November 30 to put in place a mechanism to ensure that existing digital loans

comply with the modified norms aimed at protecting the interest of customers.

- The RBI further said that the new norms will be applicable to both 'existing customers availing fresh loans' and to 'new customers getting onboarded'.
- As per the RBI, regulatory entities, like the banks and the NBFCs, have to ensure that all loan servicing, repayment, etc., shall be executed by the borrower directly in the regulatory entities' bank account without any pass-through account/ pool account of any third party.
- The guideline also said that it will be the responsibility of the regulatory entities to ensure that in **no case, disbursal** is made to a third-party account, including the accounts of Lending Service Providers (LSPs) and their Digital Lending Apps/Platforms (DLAs).

INDIA OVERTAKES U.K. TO BECOME FIFTH LARGEST ECONOMY IN THE WORLD

- India has become the world's fifth-largest economy after overtaking the UK.
- According to the **Bloomberg** report, India surpassed the UK to become the **5th** largest economy in the world.
- The IMF database and historic exchange rates were taken by Bloomberg as the basis for calculation.
- India now remains just behind the US, China, Japan, and Germany.
- According to the report, the Indian economy in 'nominal' cash terms in Q4 FY22 was \$854.7 billion. On the same basis, the U.K. was \$816 billion.

RBI TO DIGITIZE KCC

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced taking up a pilot project for end-to-end digitization of the Kisan Credit Card (KCC). The main objective of the project is the digitalization of KCC lending.
- With the automation of the processes involved, RBI aims to make lending, cost-effective and efficient for borrowers by reducing the turnaround time.




 The concept of rural credit is closely linked to inclusive economic growth, as it caters to the requirements of agriculture and allied sector along with non-farm activities viz. ancillary industries, small businesses, etc.

INDUSIND AND ADB JOIN HANDS

- IndusInd Bank has inked an agreement with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) to offer MSMEs with Supply Chain Financing.
- The Bank said, it has entered into a partial guarantee program with the ADB with an initial outlay of \$70 million (Rs 560 crore).
- ADB will provide a partial guarantee to lenders as it will cover non-payment by the borrower on the guaranteed portion of the principal and interest due.
- This collaboration will tend to improve the Bank's MSME portfolio along with strengthening its existing strategies for the sector.

NITI-BMZ DIALOGUE ON DEVELOPMENT COOPERATION

- The inaugural NITI-BMZ Dialogue on Development Cooperation was held between the NITI Aayog and the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) via video conferencing.
- The main objective of the NITI-BMZ Dialogue was focused on **five core areas** of cooperation:

In the event, the **German Federal Minister Schulze** announced additional funding of EUR 3.5 million for the implementation of SDGs in the states of India.

28TH EDITION OF THE STATUS REPORT ON INDIA'S EXTERNAL DEBT

- The 28th Edition of the Status Report on India's External Debt was released by the External Debt Management Unit (EDMU), Department of Economic Affairs (DEA), and Ministry of Finance.
- India's external debt grew by 8.2% year-on-year to reach USD 620.7 billion at the end of FY22.
- Out of the total external debt, 53.2% was denominated in US dollar terms while 31.2% was Indian rupee-denominated debt.
- The external debt to GDP ratio was 19.9% while the forex reserves to external debt ratio stood at 97.8%.
- Over 80% (USD 499.1 billion) of the external debt accounted for the long-term debt while the shortterm debt remained below 20% (USD 121.7 billion).
- The NRI deposits declined by 2% to USD 139 billion and Commercial Borrowings grew by 5.7% to USD 209.71 billion.

HDFC AND PRECISION BIOMETRIC INDIA TO TEST RETAIL PAYMENT PRODUCTS UNDER THE RBI

- The Reserve Bank of India has selected HDFC (in partnership with Crunchfish Aktiebolag) and Precision Biometric India Pvt. Ltd for the 'Test Phase' for their 'Offline Retail Payments' and 'InnalT Key Solution for Banking' products, respectively.
- These test phases will be conducted under the RBI's Regulatory Sandbox, which was launched in 2019 with the objective to promote efficiency and expand benefits to large consumers.





- The opening of the Application facility for the 'Retail Payments' theme was announced by the RBI in October 2021.
- The HDFC's **'Offline Retail Payments'** allows users to pay and receive payments in offline mode.

ESAF SFB'S "RAINBOW SAVINGS ACCOUNT"

- To promote a trans-friendly and inclusive culture, the ESAF Small Finance Bank (SFB) has launched "Rainbow Savings Account", specifically for the transgender community.
- The inaugural event was launched by the bank in collaboration with **Navodaya Movement**.
- To achieve the goal of financial inclusion of the trans-community, the savings account will have a **high rate of interest.**
- It will also have advanced **debit card** capabilities along with default **credit of interest**.

BOI: 1ST PSB TO GO LIVE ON TIN 2.0

- The Bank of India (BOI) became the first Public Sector to go live with the newly launched Direct Tax Collection System, TIN 2.0.
- Tax Information System 2.0 (TIN 2.0) is the official portal of the Income Tax Department which is under the Ministry of Finance.
- It is developed by the IT Department under National e-Governance Plan to offer the taxpayers, single window access for tax payments and other related issues.
- With the technological integration of BOI with TIN 2.0, customers will enjoy single-window access to the e-filing facility for filing tax returns.
- Since the BOI accepts direct tax collection via Over Counter (OTC) mode, the taxpayers can make the payment at any branch of the bank.

AGRIBAZAAR'S KISAN SAFALTA CARD

- Star Agribazaar Technology Private Limited launched the "Agribazaar Kisan Safalta Card" for agricultural financing.
- It is a farmer-centric card that would help farmers meet both, pre-harvest and post-harvest farm requirements.
- The Kisan Safalta Card has a twelvemonth repayment period. However, during unforeseen circumstances like crop damage due to natural calamity and poor crop yield, the payment can be rescheduled and repaid after the harvest.
- Farmer's crop yield has been set as a parameter for fixing the limit of the card. In the case of marginal farmers, the limit can be adjusted from Rs. 10000 to Rs. 50000.
- In phase I, the card will be launched in Delhi-National Capital Region (NCR), Maharashtra, Rajasthan, and Madhya Pradesh.

LIC'S NEW PENSION PLUS

- The Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) launched an Individual Pension Plan called LIC's New Pension Plus (NPP).
- It is a non-participating and Unit Linked Pension Plan with a **Unique Identification Number (UIN).**
- The investment options include Pension Bond Fund, Pension Balanced Fund, Pension Secured Fund, Pension Discontinued Fund, and Pension Growth Fund.
- The minimum entry age is 25 and the maximum entry age is 75.
- The minimum vesting age is 35 and the maximum vesting age is 85.
- The minimum policy term is 10 years and the maximum policy term is 42 years.
- The minimum premium varies with the frequency of payment.
 - For monthly payments, the minimum premium is Rs 3,000



- For quarterly, it is Rs 9,000
- For half yearly, it is Rs 16,000
- For yearly payments, it is Rs 30,000.
- There is **no cap** on maximum premium.
- In case of the **death** of a policyholder during the policy term, an amount higher than the fund value and **105%** of the total premium paid, will be paid to the nominee.

MAX LIFE'S "SMART FLEXI PROTECT SOLUTION"

- Max Life Insurance Company Ltd. launched, a threein-one, "Smart Flexi Protect Solution".
- It will provide health and enhanced life cover, in addition to market-linked investment returns.
- It is a combination of Max Life Flexi Wealth Plus, Max Life Critical Illness, and Disability Secure Rider.
- The three-in-one plan offers wealth creation together with comprehensive protection against death, disability, and critical illness.
- Flexi Wealth Plus assists in creating financial protection with life cover and savings with marketlinked returns.
- The Critical Illness and Disability Secure
 Rider provides a financial net by offering coverage amount to the individual against 64 critical illnesses and a total permanent disability.

INDIAN RAILWAYS' REVENUE SHOOTS UP

- Indian Railways' revenue grew by a healthy 38% to Rs. 95,487 crores in the first five months of FY23.
- The revenue showed an increase of Rs. 26,271.29 crores with respect to the corresponding period of FY22.
- Over the corresponding period of last year, revenue from passenger traffic grew by 116% or Rs.
 13,574.44 crores to Rs. 25,277 crores in April-August of FY23.

- Goods' revenue clocked an increase of 20% and was Rs. 65,505 crores by August in FY23.
- The growth in other coaching revenue was 50% and was calculated to be Rs. 2,437 crores in April-August of FY23.
- There was an increase of 19% in the e-Way Bills generated by businesses for the inter-state movement of goods and it touched an all-time high of Rs. 78.21 million in August.

RBI SELLS USD 13 BILLION

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) sold USD 13 billion in August 2022 to hold the Rupee at 80.
- The RBI sold about **USD 13 billion** from the forex reserves in the **spot market** to rescue the Rupee from falling further against the US dollar.
- With an aim to stabilize the exchange rates, this is the highest monthly currency market intervention by the RBI so far in FY23.
- Due to these interventions by the central bank, in the last five months, the forex reserves have plummeted by nearly USD 21 billion and currently stand at USD 533.1 billion.
- A spot market also referred to as a "liquid market" or "cash market", is a type of financial market where financial instruments such as commodities, currencies, and securities are exchanged for instantaneous delivery.

INFLATION ON A SURGE

- In the data released by the MoSPI, retail inflation spiked to 7.0% in August 2022.
- For the **eighth** consecutive month, it was above the upper limit (6%) prescribed by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
- The retail inflation for August 2022 was higher compared to 6.71% for the previous month (July 2022).
- Inflation in the food basket was measured at 7.62% in August 2022, which was higher in comparison to 6.69% in July



2022 and 3.11% in August 2021. This is being seen as the main reason behind the spike in inflation.

- The rate of price rise was more than 10% in the case of vegetables (13.23%), spices (14.9%), footwear (9.91%), and fuel & light on an annual basis.
- Static Part:
 - CPI is used to calculate retail inflation in India. It is measured by the National Statistical Office (NSO), under MoSPI.
 - CPI evaluates the changes in the price of a common basket of goods and services by comparing it with the prices in the corresponding period in the previous year.

IIP GROWTH ON A FALL

- In the Index of Industrial Production (IIP), released by the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI), India's industrial growth was measured as 2.4% for July 2022.
- The IIP had witnessed a growth of 11.2% in July 2021 but it slumped to a mere 2.4% in the latest data by the Ministry. While it was 12.7% in the previous month (April 2022).
- The industrial growth for FY23 (April-July 2022) has been 10% compared to a growth of 33.9% in the corresponding period in FY22 (April-July 2021).
- In July 2022, the manufacturing sector witnessed a growth of 3.2%. It was 10.5% for July 2021.
- The growth for the electricity sector was recorded at 2.3% for July 2022. In July 2021, it was 11.1%.
- In July 2022, the mining sector saw a negative growth (contraction) of 3.3%. During the corresponding period of July 2021, it was 19.5%.

HDFC ISSUES INDIA'S FIRST E-BG

- HDFC Bank, in partnership with National e-Governance Services Ltd. (NeSL), issued India's first Electronic Bank Guarantee (e-BG).
- The e-BG has been developed in consultation with NeSL, the Central Vigilance Commission-Central Bureau of Investigation (CVC-CBI) committee, and the Indian Banks' Association (IBA).

- The main objective behind the issuance of e-BG is to simplify the lengthy paper-based process and eliminate the possibility of fraud and manipulation.
- The paper-based process which took 3-5 days for completion has been done away with and the newly introduced electronic process does it instantly.
- Static Part:
 - NeSL was established in Bangaluru in 2016 by leading banks and public institutions and is registered with the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 (IBC). The current CEO of the company is Debajyoti Ray Chaudhuri.
 - HDFC Bank Limited is the country's largest private sector bank which was set up in 1994 with its headquarters in Mumbai. The current CEO of the bank is Sashidhar Jagdishan.

CANARA HSBC LIFE INSURANCE'S "ISELECT"

- Canara HSBC Life Insurance launched the iSelect Guaranteed Future Plan.
- It is an individual, non-participating, non-linked, savings and protection life insurance plan which especially targets new-age customers.
- The iSelect Guaranteed Future Plan will cater to both, short-term and long-term financial requirements.
- The iSelect consists of two plans:
 - iAchieve and Flexi iAchieve Plan: In this plan, the customer will be required to pay a premium for a fixed amount of time (5, 7, or 10 years) and will get a guaranteed sum at maturity. The maximum age limit to avail of this plan is 65 years.
 - iAssure and Flexi iAssure Plan: In this plan, the customer will have to pay a premium for a limited period (5, 7, or 10 years) and will get a guaranteed lump sum on maturity



including the guaranteed sum after the premium paying term. The maximum age limit to avail of this plan is 65 years.

- Easy iAchieve Plan: This plan comes with a single premium payment term (10, 12, 14, 15, or 20 years), and the customers will get a guaranteed lump sum on maturity. The maximum age limit to avail of this plan is 45 years.
- Canara HSBC Life Insurance is a joint venture between Canara Bank, HSBC Insurance Holdings Limited (HSBC IHL), and Punjab National Bank (PNB), which was established in 2008 with its headquarters in Gurugram, Haryana. The current CEO of the company is Anuj Mathur.

SBI CROSSES RS. 5 TRILLION MARKET CAP

- The State Bank of India (SBI) hit the Rs 5-trillion-mark in market capitalization for the first time.
- The SBI became the third lender bank to cross Rs. 5 trillion market cap mark after HDFC Bank Ltd. (Rs. 8.4 trillion) and ICICI Bank Ltd. (Rs. 6.3 trillion).
- In the overall context, the SBI stands as the seventh most valued Indian company with Reliance Industries in the first position, followed by TCS, HDFC Bank, Infosys, ICICI Bank, and Hindustan Unilever.
- In the past three months, SBI has outperformed the market with its stock surging 26% and touching a record high of Rs 564.45.
- Static part:
 - The SBI is the public-sector bank in India which was founded in 1955 with its headquarters in Mumbai, Maharashtra. The current Chairperson of the SBI is Dinesh Kumar Khara.

MASTERCARD'S LIGHTHOUSE MASSIV

 Mastercard announced its partnership with the United Nations Development Program on its Lighthouse Make And Scale Social Impact Vision (MASSIV) program.

- It is a free-of-charge startup partnership program that is dedicated to helping one billion (100 Cr.) people and making their lives more prosperous and secure by 2025.
- To achieve the goals set by Agenda 30, Mastercard and the UNDP will focus on financial inclusion and sustainable growth.
- The startup, through its innovative and all-board approach, will aim to solve some of the most complex global challenges, including poverty, climate change, and social and economic exclusion.
 Static Part:
 - Mastercard is an American financial services company that was established in 1966 with its headquarters in Purchase, New York. The current CEO of the company is Michael Miebach. Mastercard's Lighthouse MASSIV was launched in 2019.
 - UNDP is a part of the United Nations
 Sustainable Development Group

 (UNSDG) which was formed in 1965 with its
 headquarters in New York. The main
 objective of the UNDP is to assist
 developing and the least developed
 countries with poverty reduction and
 sustainable growth.

MOF'S GUIDELINES TO RRBS

- The Ministry of Finance issued guidelines to the **Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) to raise capital through Initial Public Offering (IPO)** and Rights Issue.
- These guidelines aim to direct the RRBs to acquire capital through issuing rights, private placements with chosen investors, viz. large banks and insurance firms, and through IPOs.
- The guidelines recommended that RRBs should first issue **bonus shares** which can be later followed by the issuance of IPOs.
- According to the guidelines, RRBs that are planning to make IPOs must have at least Rs 300 crore of net worth for the previous three years.



- It mentioned that the Capital Adequacy Ratio
 (CAR) for these banks must be above 9%, which is the minimum regulatory level.
- It also said that "Rights Issue" must be done in consultation with sponsor banks and merchant bankers.
- Static part:
 - RRBs are scheduled commercial banks which are owned jointly by the Government of India, any Nationalized Bank (aka Sponsor Bank), and respective State Governments in the ratio of 50%:35%:15%. The objective of the RRBs is to enhance financial inclusion in rural areas. The RRB was founded in 1975 under the Ministry of Finance.
 - A rights issue is a dividend of subscription rights made to the existing shareholders to purchase additional new shares in the company.

LIC CUTS ITS STAKE IN GSK PHARMA

- The Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) diluted its stake in GlaxoSmithKline Pharmaceuticals (GSK Pharma) from 6.402% to 4.357%.
- The LIC sold about 2.045% or 34.20 lakh shares of its holding in GSK Pharma during the period of September 2018-22.
- As per the LIC, in the period **of 4 years**, the stake sale happened at an average price of **Rs. 1,549.40.**
- Apart from the LIC, the General Insurance
 Corporation of India (GIC), too, holds a 1.42% stake in GSK Pharma.
- Static Part:
 - LIC is a Government of India-owned insurance and investment corporation which was founded in 1956 under the Life Insurance Corporation Act, 1956.
 - It has its headquarters
 in Mumbai, Maharashtra and its current
 Chairperson is M R Kumar.

RELIANCE GENERAL INSURANCE PARTNERS WITH PAYTM

- Reliance General Insurance partnered with Paytm to offer Reliance Health Gain Policy.
- Reliance General Insurance is a customizable health insurance product that will operate through the Paytm application.
- A total of 38 features and benefits are being offered by the Reliance Health Gain Policy.
- The policy also has a feature through which the beneficiaries can customize and personalize the policy as per their needs.
- It offers 3 plans:
- **Plus Plan-** A maximum of 2 adults and 6 children are covered.
- **Power Plan** A maximum of 4 adults and 6 children are covered.
- **Prime Plan-** A maximum of 6 adults and 6 children are covered.
- Reliance Health Gain Policy was launched by Reliance General Insurance in May 2022 with an aim to enhance insurance penetration within the country. Ravi Vishwanath is the current CEO of Reliance Health Insurance.

RBI ALLOWS BBPS TO PROCESS CROSS-BORDER INBOUND REMITTANCES

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) decided to allow the Bharat Bill Payment System (BBPS) to process cross-border inbound remittances.
- The direction was issued under Section
 10(4) and Section 11(1) of the Foreign Exchange
 Management Act (FEMA), 1999.
- From now on, foreign inward remittances received under the Rupee Drawing Arrangement (RDA), will need to be transferred to the KYC-compliant bank account of the beneficiary through Bharat Bill Payment System (BBPS).
- Before this approval by the RBI, foreign inward remittances received under RDA could be transferred to the KYC-compliant beneficiary's bank account through electronic mode, viz., National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT), Immediate Payment Services (IMPS).
- RDA is a channel to receive cross-border remittances from foreign jurisdictions. Under this,



the Authorized Category I banks enter into tie-ups with the non-resident Exchange Houses in the FATFcompliant nations to open and maintain their Vostro Account.

 Vostro is a Latin word meaning "yours". A Vostro Account is an account that a correspondent bank holds on another bank's behalf. This account acts as a way for domestic banks to access the financial services of a foreign bank.

CBDT ISSUES REVISED GUIDELINES FOR INCOME TAX OFFENCES

- Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) issued revised Guidelines for compounding offences under the Income-Tax Act 1961.
- The guidelines were issued to conform to the Government of India's policy of facilitating the Ease of Doing Business and decriminalization of offences.
- Some of the important changes made for the benefit of taxpayers include making offences punishable under Section 276 (Removal, concealment, transfer, or delivery of property to thwart tax recovery) of the Act compoundable.
- The scope of eligibility for compounding cases has been relaxed in which imprisonment for less than 2 years has now been made compoundable.
- The time limit for acceptance of compounding applications has been amended from the earlier limit of 2 years to 3 years.
- Penal interest of 2% per month up to 3 months and 3% per month beyond 3 months has been reduced to 1% and 2% respectively.
- CBDT is a statutory body that was established as per the Central Board of Revenue Act, 1963. It is administered by the Department of Revenue under the Ministry of Finance.

GROSS DIRECT TAX COLLECTIONS FOR FY23

- Gross Direct Tax collections for FY23 registered a growth of 30%.
- The Gross collection of Direct Taxes for FY23 was Rs.
 8,36,225 crores compared to Rs. 6,42,287 crores in

the corresponding period of FY22, registering a growth of **30%**.

- The Gross collection of Rs. 8,36,225 crores include, Personal Income Tax (PIT) including Securities Transaction Tax (STT), Rs. 3,98,440 crores, Corporation Tax (CIT), Rs. 4,36,020 crores.
- The net collection of Direct Taxes for FY23 was Rs.
 7,00,669 crores, compared to Rs. 5,68,147 crores in the corresponding period of FY22, registering a growth of 23%.
- The Net Direct Tax collection of Rs. 7,00,669 crores include, PIT including STT, Rs. 3,30,490 crores and CIT, Rs. 3,68,484 crores.
- The Cumulative Advance Tax collections for the FY23 were Rs. 2,95,308 crores, against Advance Tax collections of Rs. 2,52,077 crores for the corresponding period of FY22, registering a growth of 17%.
- The Advance Tax collection of Rs. 2,95,308 crores includes, CIT at Rs. 2,29,132 crores and PIT at Rs. 66,176 crores.

PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN SBI & REMITLY FOR SECURE AND EASY REMITTANCE TO INDIA

- The State Bank of India (SBI) announced its collaboration with Remitly for secure and easy remittance to India.
- The objective of this partnership is to enable the NRIs across the globe to send money to their loved ones through the SBI via Remitly.
- Through this collaboration between the SBI and Remitly, NRIs will be able to transfer money to 17 Remitly countries like the USA, Canada, the UK, France, Germany, Australia, Netherlands, etc.
- Remitly is an online remittance service that was established in 2011 with its headquarters in Seattle, Washington. The current Chairperson of Remitly is Matthew Oppenheimer.
- It is a platform that receives the money from the sender and credits it to the receiver through multiple modes viz. Direct Credit, Real Time Gross Settlement



(RTGS), National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT), and Immediate Payment Service (IMPS).

• Depending upon the form and amount of transfers, Remitly provides immediate credits with superior exchange rates and no remittance charge.

IBBI AMENDS REGULATION

- With the objective to maximize value in resolution, the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) amended the regulations.
- According to the IBBI, amendments in the regulation will provide a better market-linked solution for stressed companies.
- The changes will also help creditors fetch better value for the distressed assets.
- With the new amendments, the Committee of Creditors (CoC) will now have the power to examine whether or not a compromise or an arrangement can be explored for a corporate debtor during the liquidation period.
- One of the amendments by the IBBI will ensure that the splitting of bankrupt companies will attract more participants into the resolution process.
- IBBI, for the first time, set a minimum fixed fee for resolution professionals between Rs. 1 lakh and Rs. 5 lakh per month.
- IBBI is responsible for overseeing insolvency proceedings in India and was founded in 2016 under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 (Code) with its headquarters in New Delhi. Its current Chairperson is Ravi Mittal.

SINGAPORE CENTRAL BANK- IFSCA INDIA SIGN COOPERATION AGREEMENT

- The Monetary Authority of Singapore (MAS) and the International Financial Services Centres Authority (IFSCA) signed a Co-operation Agreement (CA) to promote regulatory collaboration and partnership in Financial Technology (FinTech).
- Under the agreement, both parties will utilize their respective Regulatory Sandboxes to assist in the experimentation of technological innovations.

- The agreement will also permit both the organizations to evaluate the worthiness of use cases which could benefit from partnership across multiple jurisdictions and invite relevant jurisdictions to participate in a Global Regulatory Sandbox.
- MAS is the central bank of Singapore that was established in 1971 with its headquarters at 10 Shenton Way, MAS Building, Singapore.
- The current Managing Director of the MAS is Ravi Menon and the current Chief FinTech Officer is Sopendu Mohanty.
- IFSCA is responsible for the development and regulation of financial institutions, financial products, and financial services in the International Financial Services Centre (IFSC), India and was established in 2020 under the International Financial Services Centres Authority Act, 2019 with its headquarters in the GIFT City, Gandhinagar.
- The current Chairperson of the IFSCA is Injeti Srinivas.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PM CARES FUND

- The Prime Minister of India, Narendra Modi, chaired a meeting of the Board of Trustees of the PM CARES Fund.
- Various initiatives undertaken under the PM CARES
 Fund, including the PM, CARES for Children scheme were presented at the meeting.
- At the event, PM Modi said that the PM CARES will assist in responding to emergency situations, through relief assistance, mitigation measures, and capacity building.
- The Prime Minister's Citizen Assistance and Relief in Emergency Situations Fund (PM CARES Fund) was created in 2020 with the objective to create a fund for combating COVID-19 and similar pandemic outbreaks in the future.

UPI PAYMENTS THROUGH RUPAY DEBIT CARDS

The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) launched the Unified Payments Interface



(UPI) payments via credit cards on the RuPay network.

- The step came after the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) permitted the linking of UPI to credit cards in June 2022.
- In this facility, the RuPay credit cards will be linked to a UPI ID or a Virtual Payment Address (VPA) to facilitate payments in an offline mode.
- The bank accounts and debit cards have already been linked to the UPI, this step will link the RuPay debit cards as well.
- Following banks were given the opportunity to go live with UPI on RuPay credit cards via the BHIM App:
- 1. Punjab National Bank,
- 2. Union Bank of India, and
- 3. Indian Bank
- Federal Bank (India) and Lulu Exchange (UAE) were given the permit to go live with Bharat Bill Payment System (BBPS) cross-border bill payments.
- UPI is a real-time payment system in India that was developed and launched by the NPCI in 2016 under the Digital India campaign.
- RuPay is a multinational card payment network that provides financial services and payment service systems. It was developed and launched by the NPCI in 2012.

BHARAT VIDYA: E-LEARNING PLATFORM

- Finance Minister, Nirmala Sitharaman, launched an e-learning platform, Bharat Vidya.
- Bharat Vidya is a first-of-its-kind online learning platform that is dedicated to Indology, South Asian, and Oriental studies, related to art, architecture, language, philosophy, etc.
- It is designed and developed by the Bhandarkar Oriental Research Institute (BORI) and will offer six courses:
- 1. Veda Vidya
- 2. Bharatiya Darshanshastra
- 3. Fundamentals of Archaeology
- 4. Sanskrit Learning
- 5. 18 Parvas of Mahabharata
- 6. Works of Kalidasa and Bhasha

- BORI will collaborate with Indian and foreign universities for awarding credits for its courses.
- At the inaugural event, Sitharaman said that the courses offered complied with the New Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

- The NIFTY Auto Fund Offer (AFO) opened on 22nd September 2022 and will close on 6th October 2022.
- The index is devised using the free float market capitalization method and comprises fifteen listed companies and auto-related sectors.
- Free float market capitalization is a method by which the market capitalization is calculated by multiplying the equity's price by the number of shares available, excluding shares held by the promoters.
- ICICI Prudential Mutual Fund is India's asset management company that was established in 1993 with its headquarters in Mumbai, Maharashtra. The current MD & CEO of the company is Nimesh Shah.

GOVERNMENT SIGNS MOU TO EXPAND SPARSH INITIATIVE

 The Gol's Defence Accounts Department (DAD) inked a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Bank of Baroda (BoB) and HDFC Bank, to expand the System for Pension Administration (Raksha) (SPARSH) Initiative.



- In order to provide last mile connectivity to pensioners, the MoU will onboard around 7,900 branches of Bank of Baroda and 6,300 branches of HDFC Bank as Service Centres.
- According to the Ministry, the Service Centres will act as an interface for SPARSH and provide an effective medium for pensioners to register grievances and seek redressal, perform profile update requests, pensioner data verification, digital annual identification, etc. regarding their monthly pension.
- The Ministry mentioned that the centers would further expand the existing network of 161 DAD offices and around 800 Service Centres provided by the SBI and the PNB branches, and 14 branches of the Kotak Mahindra Bank.
- The Ministry also said that, as part of the Common Service Centres (CSC) network, around 4.5 lakh Village Level Entrepreneurs (VLEs) will assist Defence Pensioners.
- SPARSH is a web-based system for crediting the pension directly into the bank accounts and processing the pension claims of defence pensioners without any external intermediary and was launched by the Ministry of Defence in 2021.

COLLABORATION BETWEEN TERRAPAY AND NIPL

- The Netherlands payment infrastructure company, TerraPay joined hands with India's NPCI International Payments (NIPL) to facilitate crossborder transactions for Indian consumers and merchants.
- The making and acceptance of these cross-border payments will be facilitated **by an active Unified Payments Interface (UPI) ID.**
- The Indian Customers with an active UPI ID can transact at the Quick Response (QR) locations which will be enabled globally by TerraPay.
- The collaboration between the NIPL and TerraPay is aimed at boosting the usage of UPI Applications across the world and further pushing for a cashless digital drive in India.

 Terra Payment Services (TerraPay) is a cross-border payments company that was founded in 2015 with its headquarters in Amsterdam,

Netherlands. The current CEO of the company is Ambar Sur.

NIPL is an international arm of the NPCI that was established in 2020 with its headquarters in Mumbai, Maharashtra. The current CEO of the NIPL is Ritesh Shukla.

SPECIAL ASSISTANCE TO STATES FOR CAPITAL INVESTMENT

- The Government of India (GoI) launched a scheme for Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment for 2022-23.
- Under this scheme of the Central Govt., states will receive a 50-year interest-free loan for capital investment projects.
- The scheme was announced by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman during her 2022-23 Budget speech.
- The Department of Expenditure (DoE) approved granting of loans to 4 states, namely Karnataka (Rs. 156 cr.); Jharkhand (Rs. 84 cr.); Haryana (Rs. 65 cr.); and Uttarakhand (Rs. 50 cr.).
- The total outlay of the scheme is Rs. 1 lakh crore, in which Rs. 3000 crores are earmarked for capital projects on Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) network.
- The assistance provided to the states by the Gol under this scheme will be over and above the normal permissible borrowing ceiling allowed to the states.
- DoE comes under the Ministry of Finance and is the nodal Department for looking after the public financial management system in the Central Government and matters connected with state finances.

WAPCOS FILES DRHP AT SEBI FOR IPO LAUNCH

 WAPCOS Limited filed initial papers with the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), for its proposed Initial Public Offering (IPO).



- According to the Draft Red Herring Prospectus (DRHP), the public issue with a face value of Rs 10 per equity share.
- It will be a complete offer-for-sale (OFS) of up to 3.25 crore shares by the President of India, acting through the Jal Shakti Ministry.
- The IPO is being made through the **Book Building Process, in which:**
- not more than 50% of the Offer will be available for allocation to Qualified Institutional Buyers.
- 2. not less than 15% of the Offer will be available for allocation to Non-Institutional Bidders.
- 3. not more than 35% of the Offer will be available for allocation to Retail Individual Bidders.
- WAPCOS Limited is a Government of India-owned consultancy service provider under the Ministry of Jal Shakti and was established in 1969 with its headquarters in New Delhi. The current Chairperson of WAPCOS Ltd. Is RK Agrawal.

 CCoE was in the process of establishing multiple
 cyber security centers to safeguard UBI's security.
- The Union Bank of India is a government-owned banking services company and was established in 1919 with its headquarters

WORLD BANK AND SIDBI JOIN HANDS TO LAUNCH FUND AGAINST LOAN DEFAULT

- The World Bank and the Small Industries

 to launch a fund against loan default to lenders
 financing the purchase of two and three-wheeler
 electric vehicles (EVs).
- The fund **of USD 1 billion** will be launched by the Government of India, in collaboration with the World Bank and SIDBI.
- The whole process is assisted by a South Korean grant secured by the World Bank and was signed with SIDBI on September 26.
- The NITI Aayog will act as the facilitating agency of the project and will aim to facilitate quicker and easier financing of EVs.
- The initial process of funding will include USD 300 million funds as a "first loss risk sharing instrument" which will be available to all financial institutions.
- SIDBI is a Government of India-owned company, responsible for licensing and regulation of the MSMEs and was established in 1990 with its headquarters in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh. The current Chairperson and MD of the company are Sivasubramanian Ramann.
- The World Bank was established in 1944 with its headquarters in Washington DC. The current President of the World Bank is David Malpass.

BSE GETS A NOD FROM SEBI TO INTRODUCE EGR

- The Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) received approval from the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) for introducing the Electronic Gold Receipt (EGR) segment on its platform.
- Earlier, the BSE received in-principle approval from the SEBI in February 2022, after which it conducted several mock-trading sessions for its members to facilitate trading in EGRs.

- As per the BSE, EGRs will cater to both, buyers and sellers that include individual investors, as well as commercial participants along the value chain viz. importers, jewelry manufacturers, bullion traders, banks, refiners, and retailers.
- The BSE further added that the EGR platform will provide greater assurance in the quality of gold supplied, transparency in transacting, and efficient price discovery.
- Electronic Gold Receipts are e-receipts issued on the basis of a deposit of physical gold (similar to equity shares).
- BSE is a securities market in India and was founded in 1875 as the Native Share and Stock Brokers' Association in Mumbai, Maharashtra. The current CEO and MD of the company are Ashish Kumar Chauhan.
- SEBI is a Government of India-owned market regulator and was established in 1992 with its headquarters in Mumbai, Maharashtra. The current Chairperson of the company is Madhabi Puri Buch.

RBI MONETARY POLICY COMMITTEE

- The six-member Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Monetary Policy Committee (MPC), led by the RBI Governor, Shaktikanta Das, announced several policy decisions.
- The RBI hiked the repo rate by 50 basis points (bps) to 5.90%.
- In order to curb inflation, it was the fourth consecutive increase (cumulatively 190 bps) in the current Financial Year.
- Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) and Bank Rate also saw a hike of 50 bps to 6.15%.
- The 28-day Variable Reverse Repo Rate (VRRR) auction was merged with a 14-day VRRR auction in order to counter temporary moderation in liquidity.
- The RBI also mentioned that since April, **Rupee saw** a fall of 7.4% vs. USD.
- The RBI retained its inflation projection for FY23 at 6.7%, with Q2 at 7.1%, Q3 at 6.5%, and Q4 at 5.8%.

- The RBI further slashed the FY23 GDP growth forecast from 7.2% to 7.0%.

- MPC is a six-member committee of the RBI responsible for making decisions regarding policy rates, domestic currency, inflation, and growth. It was established in 2016 and the RBI Governor (currently Shaktikanta Das) is the ex-officio Chairperson of the committee.

BOB LAUNCHES "KHUSHIYON KA TYOHAR"

- The Bank of Baroda (BOB) announced the launch of the "Khushiyon Ka Tyohaar" campaign.
- As an annual festival campaign, it provides a series of offers viz. attractive interest rates on home loans, education loans, car loans, etc.

In the meeting asked banks to be more digital savvy and use the latest technologies like Artificial Intelligence (AI) for fraud detection.

National List of Essential Medicines (NLEM) 2022

- A total of 384 drugs were included in this NLEM
 2022 list with the addition of 34 drugs,
 while 26 from the previous list were dropped.
- The notable names which were added to the list are lvermectin and Mupirocin, while common gastrointestinal medicines Ranitidine and Sucralfate have been dropped.

Cheetahs Introduced in Kuno National Park

- Project Cheetah is the world's first inter-continental large wild carnivore translocation project.
- Eight Cheetahs, five of which are female, were flown from Windhoek, Namibia to Gwalior, followed by a helicopter ride into Madhya Pradesh's Kuno Palpur.

National Logistics Policy

- The NLP aims to promote seamless movement of goods across the country and improve the competitiveness of Indian goods in domestic as well as global markets.
- It is an umbrella policy for the logistics sector which has been launched to curb logistical costs in India, which are high compared to other developed economies.

Resurgent Power acquires South East UP Power Transmission Company

- The resolution plan involved the transaction involved payment for one-time settlement of outstanding debt, purchase of equity shares worth Rs 3,251 crores, and payout of existing cash balance of SEUPPTCL.
- The shareholder funds brought in by Resurgent Power Ventures and loans raised from the State Bank of India (SBI) contributed to the completion of the transaction.

District Disability Rehabilitation Centres

- The DDRCs provide effective rehabilitation services to persons with disabilities nationwide.
- The DDRCs is run jointly by District Management Team headed by DM/Collector and a reputed Non-Governmental Organization. Indian Red Cross Society.

Tribal Peace Agreement in Assam

- Birsa Commando Force, All Adivasi National Liberation Army, Adivasi People's Army, Adivasi Cobra Military of Assam, and Santhal Tiger Force were among the tribal groups that signed the agreement.
- The objective behind signing the agreement is the upliftment of the tribal population along with the protection of their cultural, linguistic, and ethnic identities.

International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture

- The ITPGRFA is a legally binding agreement that was signed during the 31st session of the United Nations
 Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) in Rome in 2001.
- The ITPGRFA came into effect in 2004, and currently has **149 partnering nations including India**.

OCP-1 and CoE on Industry 4.0 Launched

 The soft launching was done by Arvind Kumar, Director General, Software Technology Park of India (STPI) & Chairman STPINEXT, and Atul Bhatt, CMD, Rashtriya Ispat Nigam Limited (RINL), Kalpataru.

 In the first phase, the RINL shared a few challenges pertaining to RINL's production area and through this OCP- 1, the start-ups will be selected to work in Kalpataru Project.

Board of Trustees of PM CARES Fund

- Various initiatives undertaken under the PM CARES
 Fund, including the PM, CARES for Children
 scheme were presented at the meeting.
- At the event, PM Modi said that the PM CARES will assist in responding to emergency situations, through relief assistance, mitigation measures, and capacity building.

National Programme on High-Efficiency Solar PV Modules

- The objective of this Rs.19,500 crore scheme is to achieve a manufacturing capacity of Giga Watt (GW) scale in High-Efficiency Solar PV Modules.
- The scheme aims to build an ecosystem for manufacturing high-efficiency solar Photo Voltaic modules in India that will reduce India's import dependence and will further strengthen the Atma Nirbhar Bharat initiative.

Medical Devices (Amendments) Rules 2022

- According to the Rules, all class 'A' medical device manufacturers have to register themselves through an online portal established for the purpose.
- According to the 1st Schedule of the Rules, the manufacturer will be required to give an undertaking stating that the proposed device is a class A medical device (non-sterile and/or non-measuring).

Bharat Vidya: e-Learning Platform

- BORI will collaborate with **Indian** and **foreign** universities for awarding credits for its courses.
- At the inaugural event, Sitharaman said that the courses offered complied with the **New Education Policy (NEP) 2020.**





Revised Graded Response Action Plan

- The **Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP)** is a set of actions taken to reduce air pollution in Delhi-NCR, depending on the current level of pollution.
- The directions to implement the revised GRAP were issued by the Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM), according to which the plan will come into force from October 1, i.e. 15 days before the usual date.

First Consignment of Plant-Based Meat Products Exported

- The first consignment contained **5000 kg** of plantbased meat under the National **vegan food category.**
- According to the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, the consignment consisted of hot and spicy strips, mini samosas, spring rolls, momos, grilled patty, and nuggets among other products.

Tourism Minister Launched "SymphoNE"

- SymphoNE is a series of dialogues on the North Eastern Region's Development Conference comprising policy thinkers, influencers, and stakeholders with the aim to boost the Tourism Sector in the North Eastern Region.
- The Virtual Conference is being organized on the 24th and 27th of September 2022 by the Ministry of DoNER on the occasion of World Tourism Day (27th September).

Arogya Manthan 2022

- The inauguration of Arogya Manthan marked the completion of four years of Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PMJAY) and one year of Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM).
- **PMJAY** is the **world's largest health insurance** which is fully financed by the central government. The scheme offers a sum insured of **Rs. 5 lakh** per family for both, **secondary and tertiary care.**

Vitamin Angels India partners with UNICEF

- The collaboration aims to address **undernutrition** in India and spread nutrition-related awareness in the country.
- Through the partnership, the objective is to implement a unified outreach program to enhance nutritional content, delivery, and outcomes with a prime focus on fostering immunity, health, and wellness to various diseases.

Agni Tattva- Energy for LiFE Campaign

- The campaign aims to provide a platform to **discuss** and **deliberate** upon the learning and experiences of experts and specialists and explore solutions for a **sustainable future**.
- Several vital topics focusing on health, spirituality, environment, security, consumption, and production transport will be covered as a part of the campaign.

Swachh Toycathon

- Swachh Toycathon is a unique competition in which individuals and groups will bring forth innovation in toy designs using dry waste.
- This initiative aims to fulfill the growing demand for toys along with addressing the impacts of solid waste.

- The scheme was announced by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman during her 2022-23 Budget speech.
- The Department of Expenditure (DoE) approved granting of loans to 4 states, namely Karnataka (Rs. 156 cr.); Jharkhand (Rs. 84 cr.); Haryana (Rs. 65 cr.); and Uttarakhand (Rs. 50 cr.).

Indigenous AVGAS 100LL

 The AVGAS 100 LL is a special aviation fuel meant for piston engine aircraft and Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs).

 The oil marketing company, Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) has been given the responsibility to produce and market AVGAS 100 LL in the country.

JALDOOT App and JALDOOT App e-Brochure

- In open wells, manual monitoring of water levels will be done from 1st May to 31st May for pre-monsoon water levels and from 1st October to 31st
 October for post-monsoon water levels.
- At the event, Minister Kulaste said that there was a need for states, UTs, and gram panchayats to collect the groundwater level data systematically and assimilate it into the central digital database for analysis.

Hitachi Astemo's First Solar Power Plant

- The solar power plant was installed with the objective to reduce carbon footprint so that Hitachi can achieve its target of becoming carbon neutral by 2050.
- The company, in its statement, said that an additional 1.5-megawatt (MW) solar power plant will be commissioned by March 2023.

Gandhinagar-Mumbai Vande Bharat Express

- The Gandhinagar-Mumbai Vande Bharat
 Express will run each day except for Sundays.
- It is a **16-coach train** with a capacity to accommodate **1,128 passengers.**

BANKING

India Records Double Digit Growth in Q1 FY23

- India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) in the first quarter (April-June) of the fiscal year grew by 13.5% as per the data released by the National Statistical Office (NSO).
- The GDP grew at a rate of **20.1% during the same** period last year.

IMF Approves a Loan to Sri Lanka

- The 48-month program will introduce major tax reforms including broadening the tax base for corporate income tax and VAT and making the income tax more progressive.
- The announcement of the agreement comes at a time when the Headline Inflation rose to 64.3% in August 2022, while Food Inflation soared to 93.7%.

SEBI Issues Guidelines for Stock Brokers

- As per the SEBI, the objective of the issued guidelines is to prevent instances of "mis-selling".
- SEBI has warned the stock brokers who indulged in providing algorithmic-based trading facilities offered by unregulated platforms to remove any such content referring to past or future performance of such an algorithm within a week, i.e. by **9th** September.

RBI Issued Guidelines on Digital Banking

- The Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) were given a deadline of November 30 to put in place a mechanism to ensure that existing digital loans comply with the modified norms aimed at protecting the interest of customers.
- The RBI further said that the new norms will be applicable to both 'existing customers availing fresh loans' and to 'new customers getting onboarded'.

RBI to Digitize KCC

- The main objective of the project is the **digitalization** of KCC lending.
- With the automation of the processes involved, RBI aims to make lending, cost-effective and efficient for borrowers by reducing the turnaround time.





IndusInd and ADB Join Hands

- The Bank said, it has entered into a partial guarantee program with the ADB with an initial outlay of \$70 million (Rs 560 crore).
- ADB will provide a partial guarantee to lenders as it will cover non-payment by the borrower on the guaranteed portion of the principal and interest due.

HDFC and Precision Biometric India to Test Retail Payment Products under the RBI

- These test phases will be conducted under the RBI's Regulatory Sandbox, which was launched in 2019 with the objective to promote efficiency and expand benefits to large consumers.
- The opening of the Application facility for the 'Retail Payments' theme was announced by the RBI in October 2021.

ESAF SFB's "Rainbow Savings Account"

- The inaugural event was launched by the bank in collaboration with **Navodaya Movement.**
- To achieve the goal of financial inclusion of the trans-community, the savings account will have a **high rate of interest.**

BOI: 1st PSB to Go Live On TIN 2.0

- Tax Information System 2.0 (TIN 2.0) is the official portal of the Income Tax Department which is under the Ministry of Finance.
- It is developed by the IT Department under National e-Governance Plan to offer the taxpayers, single window access for tax payments and other related issues.

Agribazaar's Kisan Safalta Card

- Star Agribazaar Technology Private Limited launched the "Agribazaar Kisan Safalta Card" for agricultural financing.
- In phase I, the card will be launched in Delhi-National Capital Region (NCR), Maharashtra, Rajasthan, and Madhya Pradesh.

LIC's New Pension Plus

- It is a non-participating and Unit Linked Pension Plan with a **Unique Identification Number (UIN).**
- The investment options include Pension Bond Fund, Pension Balanced Fund, Pension Secured Fund, Pension Discontinued Fund, and Pension Growth Fund.

Max Life's "Smart Flexi Protect Solution"

- The three-in-one plan offers wealth creation together with comprehensive protection against death, disability, and critical illness.
- Flexi Wealth Plus assists in creating financial protection with life cover and savings with marketlinked returns.

RBI Sells USD 13 Billion

- The RBI sold about **USD 13 billion** from the forex reserves in the **spot market** to rescue the Rupee from falling further against the US dollar.
- With an aim to stabilize the exchange rates, this is the highest monthly currency market intervention by the RBI so far in FY23.

Inflation on a Surge

- Retail inflation, measured as the **Consumer Price** Index (CPI), rose to 7.0% for the month of August 2022.
- For the **eighth** consecutive month, it was above the upper limit (6%) prescribed by the **Reserve Bank of** India (RBI).

IIP Growth on a fall

- In the Index of Industrial Production (IIP), released by the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI), India's industrial growth was measured as 2.4% for July 2022.
- The IIP had witnessed a growth of 11.2% in July
 2021 but it slumped to a mere 2.4% in the latest data by the Ministry. While it was 12.7% in the previous month (April 2022).



HDFC Issues India's First e-BG

- The e-BG has been developed in consultation with NeSL, the Central Vigilance Commission-Central Bureau of Investigation (CVC-CBI) committee, and the Indian Banks' Association (IBA).
- The main objective behind the issuance of e-BG is to **simplify** the lengthy paper-based process and **eliminate** the possibility of fraud and manipulation.

Canara HSBC Life Insurance's "iSelect"

- It is an individual, non-participating, non-linked, savings and protection life insurance plan which especially targets new-age customers.
- The iSelect Guaranteed Future Plan will cater to both, short-term and long-term financial requirements.

SBI Crosses Rs. 5 Trillion Market Cap

- The SBI became the third lender bank to cross Rs. 5 trillion market cap mark after HDFC Bank Ltd. (Rs. 8.4 trillion) and ICICI Bank Ltd. (Rs. 6.3 trillion).
- In the overall context, the SBI stands as the seventh most valued Indian company with Reliance Industries in the first position, followed by TCS, HDFC Bank, Infosys, ICICI Bank, and Hindustan Unilever.

Mastercard's Lighthouse MASSIV

- It is a free-of-charge startup partnership program that is dedicated to helping one billion (100 Cr.) people and making their lives more prosperous and secure by 2025.
- To achieve the goals set by Agenda 30, Mastercard and the UNDP will focus on financial inclusion and sustainable growth.

MoF's Guidelines to RRBs

• These guidelines aim to direct the RRBs to acquire capital through issuing rights, private

placements with chosen investors, viz. large banks and insurance firms, and through **IPOs.**

 The guidelines recommended that RRBs should first issue **bonus shares** which can be later followed by the issuance of IPOs.

LIC Cuts Its Stake in GSK Pharma

- The LIC sold about 2.045% or 34.20 lakh shares of its holding in GSK Pharma during the period of September 2018-22.
- As per the LIC, in the period of **4 years**, the stake sale happened at an average price of **Rs. 1,549.40**.

Reliance General Insurance partners with Paytm

- **Reliance General Insurance** is a customizable health insurance product that will operate through the Paytm application.
- A total of **38 features and benefits** are being offered by the Reliance Health Gain Policy.

RBI Allows BBPS to Process Cross-Border Inbound Remittances

- The direction was issued under Section
 10(4) and Section 11(1) of the Foreign Exchange
 Management Act (FEMA), 1999.
- From now on, foreign inward remittances received under the Rupee Drawing Arrangement (RDA), will need to be transferred to the KYC-compliant bank account of the beneficiary through Bharat Bill Payment System (BBPS).

CBDT Issues Revised Guidelines for Income Tax Offences

- The guidelines were issued to conform to the Government of India's policy of facilitating the Ease of Doing Business and decriminalization of offences.
- Some of the important changes made for the benefit of taxpayers include making offences punishable under Section 276 (Removal, concealment, transfer, or delivery of property to thwart tax recovery) of the Act compoundable.

Gross Direct Tax Collections for FY23

- The Gross collection of Direct Taxes for FY23 was Rs.
 8,36,225 crores compared to Rs. 6,42,287 crores in the corresponding period of FY22, registering a growth of 30%.
- The Gross collection of Rs. 8,36,225 crores include, Personal Income Tax (PIT) including Securities Transaction Tax (STT), Rs. 3,98,440 crores, Corporation Tax (CIT), Rs. 4,36,020 crores.

Partnership between SBI & Remitly for Secure and Easy Remittance to India

- The objective of this partnership is to enable the NRIs across the globe to send money to their loved ones through the SBI via Remitly.
- Through this collaboration between the SBI and Remitly, NRIs will be able to transfer money to 17 Remitly countries like the USA, Canada, the UK, France, Germany, Australia, Netherlands, etc.

IBBI Amends Regulation

- One of the amendments by the **IBBI will ensure that the splitting of bankrupt companies** will attract more participants into the resolution process.
- IBBI, for the first time, set a minimum fixed fee for resolution professionals between Rs. 1 lakh and Rs.
 5 lakh per month.

Singapore Central Bank- IFSCA India Sign Cooperation Agreement

- The agreement will also permit both organizations to evaluate the worthiness of use cases that could benefit from partnership across multiple jurisdictions and invite relevant jurisdictions to participate in a Global Regulatory Sandbox.
- MAS is the central bank of Singapore that was established in 1971 with its headquarters at 10 Shenton Way, MAS Building, Singapore.

Red Panda Trans-Boundary Conservation

• The partnership between the SBIF and the WWF-India was announced at the Himalayan Zoological Park in Gangtok, which is the first-of-its-kind zoological park, where animals are kept in their natural habitat.

 The event included presentations on Red Panda conservation, raising awareness among the younger generations, an inter-school quiz competition, and ended with zoo visits.

UPI Payments through RuPay Debit Cards

- The step came after the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) permitted the linking of UPI to credit cards in June 2022.
- In this facility, the RuPay credit cards will be linked to a UPI ID or a Virtual Payment Address (VPA) to facilitate payments in an offline mode.

First Auto Index Fund

- The objective behind the launch of the ICICI
 Prudential Nifty Auto Index Fund is to give investors an opportunity to earn from the expected growth in the automobile, and e-Vehicle sectors.
- The NIFTY Auto Fund Offer (AFO) opened on 22nd
 September 2022 and will close on 6th October 2022.

Collaboration between TerraPay and NIPL

- The making and acceptance of these cross-border payments will be facilitated by an **active Unified Payments Interface (UPI) ID.**
- The Indian Customers with an active UPI ID can transact at the Quick Response (QR) locations which will be enabled globally by TerraPay.

Click2Protect Optima Secure

- Click2Protect Optima Secure is a comprehensive insurance plan that aims to provide holistic protection to customers.
- It combines life and health insurance solution benefits, thereby offering simple and un-complicated financial planning for customers.

WAPCOS Files DRHP at SEBI for IPO Launch





- According to the Draft Red Herring Prospectus (DRHP), the public issue with a face value of Rs 10 per equity share.
- It will be a **complete offer-for-sale (OFS)** of up to **3.25 crore shares** by the President of India, acting through the **Jal Shakti Ministry.**

UBI's Ethical Hacking Lab

- The primary objective of this lab will be to protect the UBI's **information system**, **digital assets**, and **channels** against cyber threats.
- The Ethical Hacking Lab is equipped with a cyber defense mechanism.

World Bank and SIDBI Join Hands to Launch Fund against Loan Default

- The fund of USD 1 billion will be launched by the Government of India, in collaboration with the World Bank and SIDBI.
- The whole process is assisted by a **South Korean** grant secured by the World Bank and was signed with SIDBI on September 26.

BSE Gets a Nod from SEBI to Introduce EGR

- Earlier, the BSE received in-principle approval from the SEBI in February 2022, after which it conducted several mock-trading sessions for its members to facilitate trading in EGRs.
- As per the BSE, EGRs will cater to both, buyers and sellers that include individual investors, as well as commercial participants along the value chain viz. importers, jewelry manufacturers, bullion traders, banks, refiners, and retailers.

RBI Monetary Policy Committee

- Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) and Bank Rate also saw a hike of 50 bps to 6.15%.
- The 28-day Variable Reverse Repo Rate (VRRR) auction was merged with a 14-day VRRR auction in order to counter temporary moderation in liquidity.

BoB Launches "Khushiyon Ka Tyohar"

- The **"Khushiyon Ka Tyohaar"** campaign also includes a **discount** on **processing charges.**
- Under the campaign, the Bank of Baroda (BOB) home loans will be available at an interest rate beginning at 7.95% per annum with no processing charges.

India Slumped Two Rankings in Global Crypto Adoption Index 2022

- The American crypto analysis platform, Chainalysis, released the Global Crypto Adoption Index 2022.
- India stood at **4th** place with an index score of **0.663**, while it was ranked 2nd in the GCA Index 2021.

REPORTS

NSO Releases 15th Quarterly PLFS Report

- As per the NSO, the Unemployment Rate in India for people in urban areas declined to 7.6% during Q1 FY23 from 12.6% a year ago.
- The unemployment rate among males in urban areas dipped to 7.1% in Q1 FY23 compared to 12.2% a year ago. Whereas for females has fallen to 9.5% compared to 14.3% last year.

28th Edition of the Status Report on India's External Debt

- India's external debt grew by **8.2%** year-on-year to reach **USD 620.7 billion** at the end of FY22.
- Out of the total external debt, 53.2% was denominated in US dollar terms while 31.2% was Indian rupee-denominated debt.

The Gender Snapshot 2022 Report

- It said the rate of progress must be **seventeen times** the progress in the last decade to eradicate **child marriage** by **2030.**
- The report also highlighted that over 1.2
 billion women of reproductive age, i.e. 15 years to



49 years, live in countries with **restrictive abortion** laws.

ILO's Report on Modern Slavery

- According to the report, **modern slavery** consists of **forced labor** and **forced marriage**.
- It pointed out that by 2021, around 50 million people across the world were living in modern slavery which is up from 40 million in 2016 with an increase of 25%.

Sixth NHA Estimates Report

- The NHA Estimates Report was prepared for 2018-19 (FY19) by using an accounting framework based on the World Health Organization's System of Health Accounts, 2011.
- The NHA report presented two estimates for the expenditure incurred within the health sector during FY19: Current Health Expenditure (CHE) and Total Health Expenditure (THE).

- The primary objective of signing this MoU is to create an opportunity for these two organizations to collaborate on a series of initiatives related to the safe, orderly, and regular migration of Indian skilled professionals and youth around the world.
- The IOM and CII will come together to provide dynamism to India's migrant workforce that can meet the demands of the changing labor markets across the globe.

NCC and UNEP Sign MoU

 The primary objective of the collaboration is to end plastic pollution and achieve the universal goal of clean water bodies through the "Tide Turners Plastic Challenge Programme" and "Puneet Sagar Abhiyan".

BANK EXAMS

 The MoU was signed between Resident Representative, UN World Food Programme Bishow Parajuli and Director-General NCC Lt. Gen. Gurbirpal Singh.

MoU Between Tata Group's Airlines and CSIR-IIP

- The primary objective of this agreement is to work together on research & development (R&D), and deployment of Sustainable Aviation Fuels (SAFs).
- SAFs are made from sustainable resources, such as agricultural wastes, forestry, and used cooking oil that can be blended with fossil jet fuel to reduce emissions.

BPCL Signs an Agreement with Petrobras

- BPRL will have 40% participating interest (PI) in this concession and Petrobras, as the operator will have 60% PI.

- The total estimated value of the contract is around **USD 136 million.**

GOVERNMENT SCHEMES

MHA Launched e-Awas Portal

- The new portal will grant CAPF personnel to find houses among themselves rather than just looking for accommodation within the force.
- Shah said the housing satisfaction ratio for CAPF personnel will be enhanced to about 74% by late 2024.

CCRAS 'SPARK' Program to Support Innovative Research

- The scheme aims to support the research ideas of young undergraduate students enrolled in Ayurveda Colleges across India.
- The application process for SPARK Scheme will be completely online.

PM announces launch of PM-SHRI for upgradation of 14,500 schools across India

- It is a **centrally-sponsored scheme** for the upgradation and development of more than 14,500 Schools across the nation.
- The schools which are managed by the **Central or** State Governments will be selected and efforts will be made to strengthen them.

- Electric Freight Accelerator for Sustainable Transport India (e-FAST India) will help in finding support for innovative freight solutions.
- The platform will also provide policies to accelerate the **electrification of freight** in India.

Rajasthan's Indira Gandhi Urban Employment Scheme

- The scheme will provide **100-days** of guaranteed employment to families living in **"urban"** areas.
- The Rajasthan Government has allocated a sum of **Rs. 800 Cr.** for the scheme.

 The portal was launched as part of the special Swachhata Campaign 2.0 which will begin on October 2.

PLI Scheme for Manufacturing of Semiconductor

- The Union Cabinet, chaired by PM Modi approved modifications in the Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme "Programme for Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem in India".
- To advise and suggest the required modifications for the India Semiconductor Mission, an Advisory Committee comprising experts from industry and academia was constituted.

Government Signs MoU to Expand SPARSH Initiative

- The Ministry mentioned that the centers would further expand the existing network of 161 DAD offices and around 800 Service Centres provided by the SBI and the PNB branches, and 14 branches of the Kotak Mahindra Bank.
- The Ministry also said that, as part of the Common Service Centres (CSC) network, around 4.5 lakh Village Level Entrepreneurs (VLEs) will assist Defence Pensioners.

10th Maritime Search and Rescue Exercise SAREX-22

- It is a biennial exercise which is hosted by the Indian Coast Guard (ICG) and the Indian Search and Rescue Region (ISRR).
- The theme of SAREX-22 was- "Capacity Building towards Marine Passenger Safety".

Exercise Vostok-2022

- It is a multilateral strategic and command exercise that will be undertaken at the training grounds of the Eastern Military District of Russia.
- An Indian Army contingent of troops from 7/8
 Gorkha Rifles is in Russia to participate in the sevenday exercise.

INS Vikrant Commissioned

- INS Vikrant is the first ever aircraft carrier to be indigenously designed and constructed by India which will strengthen India's capability to operate over deep seas.
- India has joined countries like the US, Russia,
 France, the UK, and China, who are capable of designing and constructing aircraft carriers.

DRDO and Indian Army Test QRSAM

- The DRDO and the Indian
 Army conducted 6 successful flight tests of the QRSAM weapon system from the Integrated
 Test Range (ITR) at Chandipur, Odisha.
- The successful test implies that the QRSAM weapon system will be **inducted** into the Indian Army.

Japan-India Maritime Exercise JIMEX 2022

- The sixth edition marked the **tenth anniversary** of the joint exercise which began in **2012**.
- Rear Admiral Hirata Toshiyuki, Commander Escort Flotilla Four, led the Japan Maritime Self Defence Force (JMSDF) ships. While Indian naval ships were led by Rear Admiral Sanjay Bhalla, Flag Officer Commanding Eastern Fleet.

36th Tri-Services Commanders' Conference

- The two-day, 36th Tri-Services Commanders' Conference (TSCC) - South was held at Port Blair under the aegis of Andaman and Nicobar Command.
- Lieutenant General Ajai Singh, the Commander-in-Chief of the Andaman and Nicobar Command, served as the host of the conference.

Very Short Range Air Defence System

- VSHORADS missiles are capable of neutralizing lowaltitude aerial threats at short ranges.
- VSHORADS is a Man Portable Air Defence System (MANPAD) and is designed and developed indigenously by Hyderabad-based



DRDO's **Research Centre Imarat (RCI),** in collaboration with **Indian Industry Partners**, and other **DRDO laboratories**.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

CERT-In Conducts "Synergy"

- Indian Computer Emergency Response Team (CERT-In), with a joint effort of the Cyber Security Agency of Singapore, successfully conducted the Cyber Security Exercise "Synergy" for 13 Countries.
- The exercise was conducted as part of the International Counter Ransomware Initiative-Resilience Working Group.

SII Launches HPV Vaccine

- Cervical cancer starts in the cervix and according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDCP), all women are at risk for cervical cancer.
- According to the World Health Organization (WHO) data, more than 4 million women have died due to cervical cancer in India since 2019.

Mars Oxygen In-Situ Resource Utilization Experiment (MOXIE)

- Mars Oxygen In-Situ Resource Utilization
 Experiment (MOXIE) has produced the first instance of the utilization of resources in a planet's atmosphere to meet human needs.
- It was made by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) and was sent to Mars by NASA's Perseverance.

ISRO Tests Inflatable Aerodynamic Decelerator

- The IAD was designed and developed by the Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSCC) which is located in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.
- It was successfully tested in a Rohini Sounding Rocket from the Thumba Equatorial Rocket Launching Station (TERLS).

China's Ad5-nCoV Vaccine

- **CanSino's Ad5-nCoV** Vaccine was given approval by China's National Medical Products Administration for emergency use as a booster vaccine.
- Ad5-nCoV is the latest version of CanSino's one-shot Covid drug which was used by China, Pakistan, Hungary, Mexico, and Malaysia after it was rolled out in February 2021.

India's First Intra-Nasal Vaccine for COVID-19

- The vaccine **iNCOVACC** is stable at **2-8 degrees Celcius** for easy storage and distribution.
- iNCOVACC is a recombinant replication-deficient adenovirus vector (Chimpanzee Adenovirus Vectored) vaccine with stabilized spike protein.

Counter Ransomware Exercise by India and the UK

- The National Security Council Secretariat (NSCS) of India and the United Kingdom Government in collaboration with BAE Systems successfully conducted the Cyber Security Exercise for 26 nations.
- The Exercise has been conducted as part of the International Counter Ransomware Initiative-Resilience Working Group which is being led by India's National Cyber Security Coordinator (NCSC).

Paxzen: A Generic COVID19 Tablet

- **Pfizer's Paxlovid** got approval from the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA), in **2021.**
- The generic version, Paxgen, will contain a combination of two tablets, namely, Nirmatrelvir and Ritonavir.

"Taragiri" Launched In Mumbai

- Taragiri is a **149-meter-long** and **17.8-meter**wide ship that is propelled by a combination of **two** gas turbines and two diesel engines.
- The ship can move at a speed of more than 28 knots at a displacement of as much as 6,670 tonnes.

China's Qimingxing-50



- Qimingxing-50 or Morning Star-50 is China's first large-size UAV that is fully powered by a solar engine.
- Qimingxing-50 has the ability to fly uninterruptedly for months and can also function as a satellite when required.

Microprocessor-Controlled Smart Limbs

- Microprocessor-Controlled Knees (MPKs) will assist the above-knee amputees to walk with a comfortable gait.
- According to ISRO, the MPKs will offer extended capabilities to the amputees in comparison to the passive limbs which come without the microprocessors.

Avalanche Monitoring Radar

- The radar was inaugurated by Lieutenant General Tarun Kumar Aich, General Officer Commanding of Sukna-based 33 Corps at the forward posts of the Army at an altitude of 15,000 ft. in North Sikkim.
- The AMR has the capability to detect avalanches within **3 seconds** of their trigger and will act as a life saviour for troops along with reducing damage to property in high-altitude areas.

NASA's DART Mission

- The **DART Mission** was launched with the objective to test the novel technology that **changes the course** of an asteroid heading towards the Earth.
- It is the first Kinetic Impactor Method of planetary defense effort that involved a DART spacecraft colliding with the small moonlet called Dimorphos that orbits a larger asteroid named Didymos.

Integrated Cryogenic Engine Manufacturing Facility

- The ICMF will serve as a state-of-the-art facility for manufacturing Cryogenic and Semi-Cryogenic Engines.
- With an investment of **Rs. 208 crores**, the ICMF has been set up over an area of **4,500 square**

meters with over 70 hi-tech equipment and testing facilities.

SPORTS

UCI MTB Eliminator World Cup in Ladakh

- The knockout lap was a **500-meter-long track** with artificial obstacles and sharp turns.
- The event which was held at 12000 ft. above sea level, saw the participation of **twenty international**, fifty-five national, and local cyclists.

- Raised a highly-effective three-tiered counterinfiltration grid. In this 1st tier is Indian Army, 2nd tier is Central Reserve Police Forces (CRPF) and 3rd is J&K police (JKP).

USHERING INVESTMENTS

- The Jammu and Kashmir Industrial Policy 2021-30 is the flagship policy for investment and industrial growth in the UT. This policy mainly focuses on employment generation, heavily labor-intensive in nature and products/services of high in value.
- Factors that favor investments:
 - 1. Traditional products, the handicrafts produced in this region are internationally well-known.

- 2. Solution: Find customers who are willing to pay a premium amount which compensates for the disadvantages of high transportation costs.

DOGRI LITERATURE

- Dogras are well knowns as warriors and for their miniature Pahari paintings. The region between the Sutlej and Chenab rivers was called "Duggar" and its inhabitants called "Dogras". Dogras language is known as Duggar Bhasha.
- Types of Dogri Literature:

TRIBAL DEVELOPMENT STRATEGIES

• The recent data shows that total population of tribes has increased from 6.9 percent in 1961 to 8.6 percent in 2011. It nearly constitutes about 8.6 percent (10.45 Crore) of the total population of the country. Since Independence, Government of India has taken many measures to develop the tribal population of India. Even the First Five Year plan (1951-56) has given more priority to Scheduled Tribes (ST). Despite all efforts taken by Government of India, only a meagre tribal population is enjoying the Socio-Economic Development.

Main Challenges Faced by Indian Scheduled Tribes (STs):

- 1. Traditional Lifestyles
- 2. Remoteness of Habitations
- 3. Dispersed Population
- 4. Frequent Displacement

Measures taken in Five Year Plans for Scheduled Tribes:

- **1ST FIVE YEAR PLAN (1951-56):** Improve Socio-Economic Conditions of ST's in the country.
- 2nd FIVE YEAR PLAN (1956-61): Development in the field of Communication, education and culture, development of tribal economy and health, housing and water supply in Tribal areas.
- **3rd FIVE YEAR PLAN (1961-66):** Plans and policies of Second Years plan are followed to provide equality and opportunities to STs.

- 4th FIVE YEAR PLAN (1969-74): Improve the standard of living in Tribal Areas and to provide equality and social justice to all.
- **5th FIVE YEAR PLAN (1974-78):** Tribal Sub-Plan (TSP) is launched to check the direct benefits of development initiatives to the STs.
- 6th FIVE YEAR PLAN (1980-85): Ensure a higher degree of devolution of funds and earmarked poverty alleviation programme for at least 50 percent of ST families to cross the poverty line. Infrastructural facilities in scheduled areas were expanded.
- 7th FIVE YEAR PLAN (1985-90): Created two national level institutions. (i) Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation (TRIFED) in 1987 as an apex body for State Tribal Development Cooperative Corporations, (ii) National Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Finance and Development Corporation – one for SCs and other for STs.
- 8th FIVE YEAR PLAN (1992-97): Focused on eliminating the exploitation of STs and paid attention to their special problems of suppression of rights, land alienation, non-payment of minimum wages and restriction on the right to collect minor forest produce, etc.
- **9th FIVE YEAR PLAN (1997-2002):** Creation of an enabling environment conducive for STs to exercise their rights freely, enjoy their privileges and lead a life at par with the rest of the society.
- **10th FIVE YEAR PLAN (2002-07):** Focused on tacking the unresolved issues and problems faced by the tribal society on a time-bound basis.
- 11th FIVE YEAR PLAN (2007-12) and 12th FIVE YEAR PLAN (2012-17): Given direction to state Governments to design proper and appropriate developmental activities specifically relevant for the development of STs.

Developmental Parameters:

• After Five Years Plan, NITI Aayog has taken full control over development of Scheduled Tribes. About 4.3 to 17.5 percent of the total fund are



allocated to various Schemes every year for tribal development.

- 1. Livelihood Development: As per the National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) estimates, ST people living below the poverty line in 2011-201 were 45.3 percent in rural areas and 24.1 percent in Urban areas.
- Literacy and Education: The literacy rate for all categories or all age groups in Scheduled Tribes in 59 percent with 68.5 percent of Male and 49.4 percent of female.
- Entrepreneurship and Skill Development: Under Skill India Mission, the Ministry of Skill Development (MSDE) has delivering short term skills through Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) Scheme, National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and long term skills through Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) and Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs).

Recommendations:

- 1. Encourage the participation of youth, employable STs in various vocations by mapping their needs and aspiration.
- 2. Encourage Self-governance system among Tribal people where they can manage their own resources and empowering themselves.
- 3. Educational Infrastructure like primary schools and residential schools should be set up in suitable and easily accessible places.
- 4. Extra efforts could be made to enhance skill and knowledge base of the ST youth.
- 5. Measures have to be taken to improve the quality of the minor forest produce and make more tribal products available in markets.
- Intra departmental cooperation, coordination and convergence are required for the effective implementation of schemes dedicated to the upliftment of STs.

WELFARE OF TRIBES

• Government of India has made substantial efforts towards to uplift Scheduled Tribes by launching

various welfare schemes, providing soft loans at highly concessional rate of interest and increase budgetary allocation of STs even in the Union Budget 2022-23.

About Ministry of Tribal Affairs:

- Ministry of Tribal Affairs was set up in October 1999.
- It was initially with Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.
- It is the nodal ministry for overall policy planning and coordination of programs for development of STs.
- They also pay attention about overall development and well beings of the STs.
- The schemes of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs mainly concentrate on economic, education and social development of the Tribes.
- These schemes are implemented by the State Governments/Union Territory administrations.

Organizations for Development of Scheduled Tribes

- National Scheduled Tribes Finance and Development Corporation (NSTFDC): This organization is to boost the economic development of Scheduled Tribes. They collaborate with state ST corporations and banks to work for the economic upliftment of STs by providing concessional loans.
- Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation (TRIFED): This is to provide remunerative price for the Forest and Agriculture Produce of Tribal people.
- National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS): This main aim is to establish, endow, maintain, control and manage Eklavya Model Residential Schools.
- 4. National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST): The main duties of this commission are to investigate and monitor all matters relating to the safeguards provided for the Scheduled Tribes.

Scheduled Tribes refers to the tribes that the Constitution recognizes. In India there are roughly 645 different tribes.

 The 2011 Census Report mentions 135 recognised scheduled tribes and 250 ethnic communities in the region of North East India. The percentage of tribal population in the seven states of the region is also very high.

About Pradhan Mantri Van Dhan Yojana (PMVDY)

- This programme was unveiled by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on April 14, 2018.
- The main aim of this programme is to uplift the lives of tribal people and bring positive changes in their life and their social economic status will raise.
- The nodal agency for PMVDY is Tribal Cooperative Marketing Federation of India (TRIFED).

Van Dhan Vikas Kendra Clusters (VDVKCs)

- VDVKCs clusters constituting 15 tribal SHGs/Van Dhan Kendras with the latter comprising up to 20 tribal forest produce gatherers or artisans.
- Like this each cluster covers about 300 beneficiaries.

Changes in Assam:

- The most significant aspect of the Pradhan Mantri Van Dhan Yojana programme in Assam covers around 92,119 beneficiaries and created a brand called TRISSAM.
- It is launched in September 202 and it is designed and developed by Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship, Guwahati.
- In TRISSAM, the Minor Forest Products includes wild honey, black rice, joha (aromatic) rice, bora (sticky) rice, aijong rice, muri (puffed rice), etc.

Changes in Manipur:

• In Manipur, 200 VDVK have been set up and 60,400 beneficiaries.

- Forest products manufactured by the beneficiaries having found good market response, impacting the tribal ecosystem as never before in Manipur.
- It has provided employment to tribal women and improved their financial conditions.

Changes in Mizoram:

- 159 VDVK's are set up with 46,168 beneficiaries in Mizoram.
- The programme aims to bring about sustainable livelihood for forest based tribal people by facilitating skill updation, capacity building, and training as well as promoting value addition to various minor forest produce.

Changes in Nagaland:

- Nagaland has 206 Van Dhan Clusters covering about 61,800 beneficiaries.
- The Van Dhan clusters have also emerged as new centres of economic empowerment for the tribal communities by way of receiving support in terms of financial capital, training, mentoring, etc. in order to expand their business and enhance earnings.

Changes in Tripura:

- PMVDY programme in Tripura was launched in January 202 with the central grant of Rs. 2.26 crore.
- 27 Van Dhan Vikas Kendras covering beneficiaries up to 8,100.
- During 2020-21, VDVKs have provided warehouses for storage and add on equipment etc.

Changes in Meghalaya:

- 39 VKDK clusters have been set up covering 11,000 beneficiareis.
- Meghalaya being a leading producer of plum, pineapple, orange, apricot, litchi, kiwi, jackfruit, peach, pear,etc. the VKDKs have also identifies these for value addition under the Yojana.

RECONSIDERING INDIGENOUS KNOWLEDGE SYSTEM

 Despite a large number of schemes and programmes, the 104 million tribal people have remained marginal – geographically, socioeconomically and politically. Tribal communities, though marginalized, have rich Indigenous Knowledge Systems (IKS) which could be useful if they are properly integrated in modern and contemporary knowledge system.

Key Issues and Concerns

- Tribal communities continue to face challenges in terms of preservation and expansion of their traditional knowledge.
- Indigenous knowledge is often compared with modern knowledge, such arguments are made on grounds such as lack of validation, accreditation and scientific authenticity.
- Poor documentation that is the non-availability of a full-fledged institutional framework to map, profile, and accredit the large body of indigenous knowledge and innovations.
- Misappropriation of indigenous knowledge in the form of "biopiracy". When researcher's appropriate indigenous traditional knowledge without proper procedure, acknowledgement or benefit-sharing agreement, this considered biopiracy.

Recommendations:

- 1. Establishment of dedicated research lab to validate and accredit various indigenous innovations.
- 2. Government should create a National Consortium of Indigenous Knowledge Resource Centre.
- 3. Strong legal framework and protection is needed for indigenous knowledge.
- 4. Students should be created awareness about the skills and knowledge of indigenous knowledge.

5. Make indigenous communities to participate in various decision-making institutions related to their society.

 In 1991 the literacy rate of the Scheduled Tribes was 29.60 percent as compared to 52.21 percent for the general population. The gap between the two was as high as 28.09 percent. In order to improve their economic standard, many schemes are implemented by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs with target of uplifting the education among the tribal communities with specific focus in the Scheduled Tribe dominated areas of the country.

- National Overseas Scholarship (NOS) to the ST Students for Studies Abroad: Financial assistance is provided to 20 ST students every year for pursuing higher studies abroad.
- 4. **Pre-Matric Scholarship:** Financial assistance is provided to ST students studying in Classes IX and X.
- 5. **Post –Matric Scholarship:** Financial Assistance is provided to ST students studying beyond class X.
- Support to Tribal Research Institute (TRI): Aims to strengthen TRIs to carry out research, documentation, training and capacity building

activities and serve as a knowledge hub catering to overall tribal development.

Recommendation:

- Identify Special Education Zones (SEZs) need to be identified. These zones are with large tribal population having no educational and socio economic development.
- 2. Frame curriculum according to their traditions, aspirations and needs.
- 3. Multilingual education is required and the medium of instruction should be their mother tongue.
- Special attention should be given to employing local teachers or those having familiarity with local languages.
