An Online Platform to Issue COO for Exporters-Launched Commerce Industry

• The Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) will facilitate with an emergency working capital of up to Rs 1 crore against their confirmed government orders to Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs).

**RBI's Current Notification--Auction of Government of India Dated Securities** 

• RBI has released a notification describing auction **GOI's three securities for a amount of Rs 20,000 crore.** The total amount retained over and above the notified will not exceed Rs 20,000 crore in first half of FY 2020-21 and will be set-off in second half year.
